

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

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

2.0 CHEMICAL COMPOSITION & PROCESS

All plates are of Fully Killed steel.
Drum plates shall be of Vacuum Degassed. (S1 of SA20).
Final rolling: lengthwise.
Plate thickness (t) > 80mm to be made only from ingots. Plate of t <= 80mm, can be made from continuous cast slabs. Reduction ratio in thickness from slab/ingot to plate shall be 3:1. Sufficient 'Top of Ingot' to be discarded to ensure plate free of segregation. After top discard the increase in Carbon content at the top-mid, width-mid thickness of the plate shall not exceed 20% of the reported ladle analysis value. This value shall be reported in Test Certificate.
Ladle analysis: 1 sample per cast, Product analysis: min.1 sample per plate as rolled.
Max. Carbon: CS: 0.25%. Max. Carbon Equivalent for Carbon Steel: As per S20 of SA20.

8.0 REPAIRS AND FINISH

Plates to be free of loose mill scales, edge crack & other injurious defects. Repairs by fusion welding are prohibited. Mechanical removal of defects are permitted subject to min. thickness & smooth surface.

9.0 MARKING

Specification, grade, Melt number, Size, Plate number, Maker's emblem/ code and Inspecting Authority's seal to be stamped on each plate. For plates over 6mm marking shall be by stencilling & steel die stamping and for 6mm and below marking shall be by stencilling & steel die stamping using low stress on each plate & bordered by white paint. In addition for SA387 each plate shall be legibly stamped with the letter N to indicate for normalised and tempered plate. Rolling direction shall be marked by paint. PO No., "BHEL - Tiruchirappalli" & weight to be painted on the product.




Flats to be in hot / cold rolled coiled form and shall be of weldable quality.

3.0 DIMENSIONAL TOLERANCES

Thickness : As per specification

Coil ID: 508 mm

Width : +/- 0.5 mm

Coil OD: 1800 mm (max.)

Coil weight : 2 Tonnes (max.)

4.0 FINISH AND REPAIRS

Flats to have a workman like finish, be free of harmful defects like cracks, laminations, scrabs etc., and surfaces to be free from scales, rust, pitting, wrinkles etc.

For hot rolled coils the edges of coils to be of machine cut (cold slit) ends in order to ensure squareness of edges & flatness of width. Edges cut by shearing or hot saw cut are not acceptable.

Flats to be without fish tails. Coils should not contain any weld seams.

Repair by fusion welding is prohibited. When Defects are rectified by mechanical means, min. thickness as per specification shall be met and the rectified areas to be smoothly dressed up.

5.0 MARKING

Following details to be marked on the flats at ends of coils & on the packing by paint stenciling.

1. Specification and grade
2. Melt number
3. Purchase order No.
4. Maker's emblem/code
5. Coil number and Weight
6. Size (width & thickness).

6.0 PRESERVATION AND PACKING

It is the responsibility of the supplier to ensure that no damage occurs during transit.

Coils to be applied with a suitable rust preventive to avoid rusting during transportation & storage, which will not produce defects like porosity in welding.

Individual coils to be packed in air/water tight polythene covering of sufficient thickness and strength to withstand rigorous handling.

Further, the coils to be rigidly packed with Galvanised Iron sheets along the circumference and end caps at both ends. Coils to be wrapped with 1 inch hoop iron bands at one place along the circumference and at 8 places through the eye of the coil and supported on suitable wooden skids/ steel crates. A handling hook to be provided for lifting by crane.

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

7. This guarantee will not be discharged due to the change in the constitution of the Bank or the Contractor(s).

8. It shall not be necessary for the company to proceed against the contractor before proceeding against the guarantor-bank and the guarantee herein contained shall be enforceable against them notwithstanding any security, which the company may have obtained or obtain from the Contractor shall, at the time when proceedings are taken against the guarantor hereunder be outstanding or unrealised.

Offers should be firm for net FOB Nearest Sea Port price and C&F Chennai port, indicating the shipping specifications and the earliest delivery irrespective of offers from overseas suppliers. Offers from indigenous sources shall be firm for FOR TIRUCHIRAPPALLI

2. DOCUMENTS:

(1) Offers should be accompanied by detailed technical literature, catalogue and detailed dimensional drawings in ENGLISH and in TRIPLICATE, or otherwise, the offers will not be considered.

(2) In case overseas suppliers route their offer through their accredited selling agents, a letter of authority should be furnished mentioning the name and address of their selling agents, who are authorized to bid, negotiate and conclude a contract on their behalf.

3. AGENCY COMMISSION:
