### I. PRE - QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

1. The Bidder should have valid Service Tax registration number (If applicable) otherwise has to submit a Self-Declaration of "Non Applicability of Service Tax" (Format enclosed with this tender document) on their Company's Letter Head.
2. The Bidder should have valid Income Tax **PAN Card**. Documentary proofs / Xerox copies are to be enclosed.

### A) Brief Description:

APPROX. TOTAL WT IS 281 MT. (Refractory material 200 MT & Structural 81 MT)

Structural and machinery items broadly include:

- 1) Furnace shell, supporting columns, platforms with handrails etc.
- 2) Firing system,
- 3) Airlines with its valves and its headers,
- 4) Gas lines and gas valve train,
- 5) Doors and its drive and counterweights,
- 6) Bogies with its driving mechanism,
- 7) Blowers with its motors,
- 8) Exhaust ducts, dampers, recuperators etc.

The Furnace is to be totally dismantled at BHEL Trichy, HPBP-Building 1, bay 1-A. Following is the brief description of work:

- 1) Removal of LPG system and its lines from inlet to Gas train and gas train to all burners zonal lines individual lines to burners all LPG Gas lines and Headers is to be removed from the Furnace (Gas train, All gas lines, Headers, Zonal lines, Individual lines to burners).
- 2) Removal of PG system and its lines from inlet to all burners journal lines individual lines to burners all PG GAs lines and Headers is to be removed from the Furnace (All gas lines, Headers, Zonal lines, Individual lines to burners). All fuel lines will be purged with nitrogen first if it is required to cut the line for dismantling. Decision of cutting the line will be solely taken by BHEL gas and service supervisor.
- 3) Removal of Air lines related to furnace from blower to burners and zonal lines individual zonal lines Air headers and instrumentation impulse airlines etc.
- 4) Removal of Flue gas line from Furnace to chimney.
- 5) Removal of FD fans and ID fans from its locations.
- 6) Removal of Doors and its lifting mechanism including counter weights & chains/Ropes.
- 7) Removal of Bogie drive mechanism and Bogie from Furnace.
- 8) Split the bogie in to 2 or 4 pieces according to transport convenient.
- 9) Removal of Door columns and cross beams from both side of the furnace.
- 10) Removal of platforms and hand rails from furnace.
- 11) After giving suitable supports shell may split in to 2 or 3 pieces according to Transport convenient.
- 12) Removal of Chimney in to three or four pieces according to transport convenient.
- 13) Packing and moving of all above items to PPPU/Thirumayam.

- 14) Already fabricated New 2 numbers of Doors, 4 numbers of Door columns and 2 numbers of Door Masts to be moved from facility yard to PPPU (Old removed door accessories including 2 numbers of Doors, 4 numbers of Door columns and 2 numbers of Door Masts to be moved to BHEL Trichy scrap yard)
- 15) Removed All the PG Burners, Pipe lines to be handed over to Gas & Services/Trichy and all the unwanted debris to be moved to the identified area.

### **B) Dismantling of refractory items**

- 1) Safe removal (wherever possible and feasible practically) of old refractory fire bricks/insulation bricks and stacking of the same categorily,
- 2) Breaking of fire clay mortar/refractory castables and disposal of the same,
- 3) Breaking and safe disposal of the damaged refractory bricks from the different parts of the furnace such as bogies, the fixed hearth etc. at indicated place by BHEL supervisor.  
Total approx. weight of refractory 200 tons. The contractor has to adopt and ensure adequate safety for their employees during execution of the work.

### **C) Removal and handling of ceramic fiber module**

Removal of damaged ceramic fiber modules/SS studs insulation lining of different densities from the wall/roof/door of the furnaces as per Instructions of Supervisor/ Refractory maintenance /M&S. The contractor has to move the debris /wastages collected out of the above work and dispose them at identified disposal points as per Instructions of Supervisor/ Refractory maintenance /M&S. Ceramic Fiber module in good working condition is to be piled up safely at indicated place and is to be loaded on arrival of lorry/truck/trailer for dispatching to PPPU Thirumayam. The contractor has to adopt and ensure adequate safety for their employees during execution of the work.

### **D) Removal and handling of ceramic fiber Blanket**

Removal of damaged ceramic cup locks, Ceramic fiber blanket insulation lining of different densities from the wall/roof/door of the furnaces as per Instructions of Supervisor/ Refractory maintenance /M&S. The contractor has to move the debris /wastages collected out of the above work and dispose them at identified disposal points as per Instructions of Supervisor/Refractory maintenance/M&S. Ceramic blanket in good working condition is to be piled up safely at indicated place and is to be loaded on arrival of lorry/truck/trailer for dispatching to PPPU Thirumayam. The contractor has to adopt and ensure adequate safety for their employees during execution of the work.

### **E) Manual handling/loading of refractory**

Refractory bricks which have been identified as good ones and stacked are to be packed and loaded on the lorry/truck/trailer for dispatching to PPPU Thirumayam. Contractor has to ensure the minimum refractory breakage during the handling.

### F) Crane hiring in HPBP outside shop area

Supply of 1 No of Tyre mounted mobile crane with crew of suitable capacity having boom length minimum 22 mtr for assisting dismantling of chimney, blower work at HPBP Trichy. Dismantled partitions of the chimney have to be brought down safely without any distortion and to be loaded on the suitable vehicle indicated by BHEL supervisor for the transporting to PPPU Thirumayam. Providing the lifting, rigging and loading support for dismantling activities for the 40 ton furnace parts which are not in approach of shop EOT cranes. Maximum weight of any single unit to be handle will be 20 ton only.

### G) Dismantling of total electrical installation:

- 1) Safe removal and movement of Instrumentation items and electrical items from the furnace after isolation of Power and Gases.
- 2) Safe removal and movement of all power cables and control cables of furnace after disconnection after isolation of Power,
- 3) Safe removal and movement of all the electrical control panels, field panels, instrumentation panels, junction boxes and peripherals etc. after isolation of Power,
- 4) Safe removal of all instrumentation system, Recorders, thermocouple cable, HT transformer Solenoid valves, ignition systems of all burners after isolation of Power and Gas. Prior intimation is to be given and permission is to be obtained from BHEL electrical supervisor. Above removed all electrical items will be moved to BHEL Thirumayam by Transportation.

### H) Movement of dismantled Structural, machinery items

Movement of all the dismantled structural and machinery items in a safe manner for loading on lorry/trailer for movement to PPPU Thirumayam. The contractor has to ensure no damage to the all machinery and structural items during movement/transit and safe unloading off the transport vehicle in the supervision of the BHEL supervisor at PPPU Thirumayam.

### I) Movement of dismantled Refractory material

Movement of all the dismantled refractory and ceramic items in a safe manner for loading on lorry/trailer for movement to PPPU Thirumayam. The contractor has to ensure minimum damage to the all items during movement/transit and safe unloading from the transport vehicle in the supervision of the BHEL supervisor at PPPU Thirumayam.

### J) Manual handling/unloading of refractory items

Unloading of all the shifted refractory and ceramic items in a safe manner from lorry/trailer for Stacking /piling at PPPU Thirumayam. The contractor has to ensure minimum damage to the all items during unloading off the transport vehicle in the supervision of the BHEL supervisor.

### K) Erection of Machinery, structural items at PPPU Thirumayam

- 1) Check the foundation and erection of Furnace shell in its position.
- 2) Removal of all cross supports given in the chamber to be removed.
- 3) Re-joining of Furnace shell pieces with suitable insulation blankets as per our instruction.
- 4) Modification of Furnace chamber side wall casting fixing area as per the instruction of BHEL Supervisor.
- 5) Fixing of Door columns and door masts at the location according site condition. (If any alteration work required to be done) Also Door mechanism to be fixed. Roof sheet near the doors (width= 2 meter from doors, Length= width of the furnace) is to be changed with new Stainless Steel 316 with sufficient stiffeners and joints as per the instruction of BHEL supervisor. New sheet will be provided by BHEL at free of cost.
- 6) Fixing of all platforms and hand rails at proper location and welding.
- 7) After suitable modification (Modification - Welding plates and removal of some refractory items in the bottom side one row and closure of all PG opening on one side & LPG opening on the top with plate and insulating modules to be fixed) in the shell all LPG burners to be fitted at bottom side on both side as per our instruction.
- 8) Laying of LPG pipe lines & its accessories on one side and other side after suitable modification in LPG header pipe line length and connect to the burners, fixing of LPG gas train assembly also. This includes fixing all valves, orifice plates, Zonal valves etc. All these LPG works will be done in the supervision of BHEL'S Gas and Services supervisor.
- 9) Fixing of FD and ID fans in its location and laying of all air pipe lines & its accessories in all four zones as per Orientation of Blower station at PPPU after modification of Header pipe length on one side and connect it to the burners. This includes fixing all valves, orifice plates, Zonal valves etc.
- 10) Fixing of Chimney in its position. The Flue ducts to be suitably modified / Extended and insulated and to be connected to the chimney.
- 11) It can be asked to dismantle the Bogie parts further in to pieces in order to re-strengthen the bogie structure and it will be solely decided by BHEL supervisor. Bogies to be connected and positioned in the rails. Bogie mechanisms also to be fixed. High temperature grease will be applied to all the moving parts of the bogie as per the instruction of BHEL supervisor. Free running of bogie and sand sealing of bogie and hearth to be ensured. There may be problem in movement at high temperature. Hence the clearance should be suitably planned.
- 12) After Fixing of Doors, Door mast & counter weights guiding channels and locking hooks to be provided at proper places. Smooth moving of Doors to be ensured at Room temperature and at Elevated temperature (1050 deg. C)
- 13) Contractor has to ensure the perfectly sealed shell surface. It should be free from any kind of undesired openings.
- 14) Leak testing of LPG lines to be done and to be corrected if any leak found.

- 15) During testing with FD fan any leakage in airline to be arrested.
- 16) Entire furnace shell, bogie and other structural items are to be spot cleaned thoroughly for fabrication (specially the portion where welding is to be carried out). Weakened portions will be strengthen using stiffeners or will be fabricated newly as per the instruction of the BHEL supervisor.
- 17) Entire furnace along with its all field equipment will be cleaned using emery paper, grinding etc. before painting. Paint ability of the surface is to be checked by BHEL supervisor. Painting will be done after BHEL supervisor's acceptance for surface cleaning. Painting schedule for different equipment, fuel line, air line will be given by BHEL on the site. Maximum no. of paint coats for one equipment/area is two (excluding primer/red oxide coating). One coat of primer/red oxide is to be applied wherever required as per the instruction of BHEL supervisor.

### L) Crane hiring in PPPU outside shop area

Supply of 1 No of Tyre mounted mobile crane of suitable capacity with crew having boom length minimum 22 mtr for assisting erection of chimney, blower work at HPBP, Trichy. Dismantled and transported partitions of the chimney, all the blowers have to be moved and assembled up safely without any distortion. Providing the lifting, rigging and loading support for erection activities for the 40 ton furnace parts which are not in approach of shop EOT cranes. Maximum weight of any single unit to be handle will be 20 ton only.

### M) Laying & Erection of refractory item

Construction of refractory wall/Bogie/hearth, door of the furnaces using refractory fire bricks/insulation bricks and binding fire clay mortar cement as per Instruction of BHEL Supervisor. Proper gap is to be maintained wherever needed. Sufficient expert/experienced masons with helper must be involved by contractor for this work.

### N) Ceramic fiber laying work- module

Welding spot on the shell should be thoroughly cleaned off rust. Positioning and fixing of ceramic fiber module insulation block after welding studs on the side wall / roof/door of the furnace and locking them with metal locks as per Instructions of Supervisor/Refractory maintenance/M&S.

### O) Ceramic fiber laying work- blanket

Positioning and fixing of ceramic fiber blanket insulation lining of different densities on the welded studs on the side and rear wall / roof/door of the furnace and locking them with ceramic cup locks or with metal locks., closing the cup lock with Refractory mortar as per Instructions of Supervisor/Refractory Maintenance /M&S as per erection drawing (will be provided at the time of erection).

### P) Total Electrical re-installation

1. Safe movement and positioning of Instrumentation items and electrical items at the location indicated by BHEL Electrical supervisor at PPPU Thirumayam,

2. Safe movement and laying of all power cables and control cables (including handling the trench covers wherever required) of furnace as per the instruction of BHEL supervisor at PPPU Thirumayam,
3. Safe movement and erection of all the electrical control panels, field panels, instrumentation panels, junction boxes and peripherals etc. as per the instruction of BHEL supervisor at PPPU Thirumayam,
4. Safe movement and fixing of all instrumentation system, ignition systems of all burners as per the instruction of BHEL supervisor at PPPU Thirumayam.

### Q) NOTE:

1. All the LPG lines to be extended should be welded - root TIG welding and arc welding over TIG deposit with qualified welder.
2. All the pipe lines should be properly supported and welding should be carried out as per BHEL requirement.
3. Wherever insulation is damaged during dismantling or during handling or during transporting the same should be replaced. Insulation material will be provided by BHEL at free of cost.
4. Modification in the chamber, Pipe lines, Door guide mechanism, Counter weight mechanism etc. Should be properly welded and required supports/Gussets to be given as per our instruction.
5. During commissioning of the subject Furnace by BHEL, if any short fall/defect/setback if any observed in re-erection work- Contractor has to correct/complete the same at free of cost. Commissioning support by the contractor's helpers shall be given to BHEL on the request of Executive/M&S/PPPU.

### R) Special Instruction:

1. Tenderer should necessarily visit both the location site at Trichy & PPPU/Thirumayam before quoting and to know the quantum/nature of job and facilities.
2. The rates quoted should be FIRM throughout the contract period.
3. The rates quoted includes the Cost of DIESEL/LUBRICANTS, Repair & Maintenance expenditure, Spare parts, Tools etc., of Trailer, Crane, payment to Driver and cleaner of trailer, payment to operator, helper and rigger of crane , and labours involved in dismantling ,handling and erection work.
4. The duration the contract is maximum THREE MONTHS from the date of commencement of work. The contractor shall arrange sufficient no. of work force and facilities to complete the job within target time.

### T) Contractor's scope:

1. Contactor should bring experienced & skilled persons / unskilled man powers, suitable Welding machine with cable and holders, Gas Cutting torch with hoses, regulators etc., & Gouging set with accessories - complete set for material dismantling/handling work.
2. Grinding Machine with accessories.
3. All hand tools, measuring instruments and accessories etc.
4. All safety equipment including PPE like Helmet, Safety shoe, Gloves, Goggles, Safety belts etc. necessary for the work shall be arranged for by the contractor at his cost.

- f) "BHARAT HEAVY ELECTRICALS LIMITED" (herein after referred to as BHEL) shall mean the Board of Directors, Chairman, Executive Director, General Manager or other Administrative Officer of the said Company including Executive/CONTRACTS/PPPU authorized to invite tenders and enter into contract for works on behalf of the Company.

- j) A "working day" means, any day other than that prescribed by the NEGOTIABLE INSTRUMENTS ACT as being a Holiday, and consists of the number of hours of labour as commonly recognized by good employers in the trade in the district where the work is carried out or as laid down in the BHEL regulations.

**02. HEADING TO THE CONTRACT CONDITIONS:** - The heading to these conditions shall not affect the interpretations thereof.
