GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. INVITING TENDERS

Tenders in two part bids are invited from 'MICRO & SMALL ENTERPRISES (MSE's)' only for supply of 'Wooden boxes & Planks' as per BHEL drawings on 'Annual rate contract basis'. Dimension of Boxes shall be as per drawing.

Bidders should primarily be engaged in wooden boxes/crates manufacturing/wooden items. BHEL may carry out evaluation of bidder's capability. BHEL reserves the right to accept/reject any offer based on evaluation of bidder's capability. BHEL may decide to visit the bidder(s) works. Any fact found deviating from bids during evaluation shall make the bidder liable to be dis-qualified. BHEL reserves the right to ask any or all bidder to furnish previous work experience for technical evaluation purpose.

"MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit along with the offer, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (five years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM II) or valid NSIC certificate or EM II certificate along with attested copy of a CA certificate (Format enclosed at Annexure -1 where deemed validity of EM II certificate of five years has expired) applicable for the relevant financial year (latest audited). Date to be reckoned for determining the deemed validity will be the date of bid opening (Part 1 in case of two part bid). Non submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bid at par with other bidders. No benefit shall be applicable for this enquiry if any deficiency in the above required documents are not submitted before price bid opening. Documents should be notarized or attested by a Gazetted officer."

"If an enterprise is falling under any of the three categories of enterprises as defined in the Act, graduates to a higher category from its original category or beyond the purview of the act, it shall continue to avail all non-tax benefits of its original category notified by the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises for a period of three years from the date of such graduation to the higher category".

Sealed tenders in two parts; Part-I: Techno-commercial bid and Part-II: Price bid are hereby invited as per applicable specifications and Drawings provided by BHEL. The relevant documents are attached with the Enquiry.

In case of discrepancy between prices in figures and words, prices in word will be considered as final. Anything other than prices mentioned in the price bid or prices in any other units shall be considered invalid. Rates should be quoted per box only.
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Both the sealed envelopes should be put in outer sealed envelope superscribing all details i.e. Enquiry Number, Date, Supplier's Name and Address and Item.

Time of submission by 1500 Hrs on Due Date. Time of Techno-Commercial bid (Part I) opening is 1530 Hrs on due date. Based on evaluation of techno-commercial offers, Price bids of bidders who qualify from techno-commercial evaluation shall be opened.

Sealed Tenders can be dropped in the tender box labeled as 'Tender box for MM contracts'. This tender box is located at the entrance of Admin block BHEL Goindwal. Fax (01859-222061) / E-Mail (tendermm@bheliip.in) offers received in time shall be considered only when such offers are complete in all respects.

CST, VAT & Excise duty + any cess on ED at the rates applicable shall be payable extra against ED Gate Pass valid for CENVAT benefit. Rates should clearly mention basic price of the item for per box and FOR Goindwal basis. Unloading of material at Main Stores of BHEL shall be arranged by BHEL. Order of enquiry item sl. No. shall be maintained in the quotation. The rates quoted shall be firm and fixed. No price variation is proposed and allowed for full year.

Variation in excise duty, sale tax/ vat or any other statutory levies during contractual delivery period shall be to BHEL's account

Bidders, who are not currently on registered list of BHEL IVP Goindwal Sahib, may submit their application for vendor registration through online system on www.bhel.com. Direct link for online supplier registration is <https://supplier.bhel.in/>. This application submission can be done separately/immediately without waiting for the tender opening.

BHEL reserves the right to reject offer of any bidder based on past performances/previous participation in rate contracts for supply of wooden boxes and planks with our unit.

Part-I: Techno-Commercial bid should contain

- The details/data/ information/ supporting certificates for MSE as per requirement.
- Acceptance of Techno-Commercial terms and conditions should be attached next. This can be attached either by signing each page of terms and conditions & Drawings or a confirmation statement. Any deviation proposed by bidder shall be considered by BHEL at its own discretion; and if finally considered, shall carry loading factor at the discretion of BHEL.
- Un priced price bid, filling all other details except prices.
- Monthly CFT commitment to be mentioned in bid**

Sealed quotations shall reach by 1500 Hrs on due date. Part-I shall be opened on due date at 1530 Hrs. Based on evaluation of pre-qualification and/or techno-commercial offers, Price bids of bidders who qualify from

pre-bid qualification and techno-commercial evaluation shall be opened. Date of opening of Price bid shall be informed to all successful bidders.

Part II: Price Bids should contain:

Price quotation format shall be as attached.

Present rate of VAT/CST & Excise duty + any cess on ED shall be mentioned in the table as %. All duties shall be paid extra. However, the comparison among bidders shall be done on the basis of quoted rates converted to "Total landed cost to BHEL". Duties shall be payable extra against ED Gate Pass valid for CENVAT benefit.

Price quoted shall be firm and not subject to any escalation during the PO execution.

Price should be quoted on FOR Destination Goindwal Sahib basis. If not mentioned, it shall be concluded that the offer is on FOR Destination Goindwal Sahib basis.

IF THE OFFER IS NOT ACCOMPANIED WITH ACCEPTANCE OF TERMS AND CONDITIONS, IT SHALL BE CONCLUDED THAT ALL THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS ARE ACCEPTABLE AND NO CLAIM WHATSOEVER SHALL BE ENTERTAINED LATER ON.

2. VALIDITY OF OFFERS:

The offers shall be kept open for acceptance for **90 days** from the date of opening of the tender. In case of extension of tender opening date, the validity shall be suitably revised.

VALIDITY OF CONTRACT:

The rate contract will be in operation for one year from **16.06.2016 to 15.06.2017** and may vary one month from this rate contract period. However, BHEL reserves the right to terminate the contract earlier also if the performance of the VENDOR is not satisfactory. The rate contract can be again for one more year on mutual agreement. BHEL reserves the right to short close rate contract earlier. All POs will be released in this contract period. Purchase orders will be released in this rate contract period only.

3. SCOPE OF SUPPLY

Material shall be made of specified material as per the applicable latest Material Standard requirements/Drawing/Technical Delivery conditions attached and other requirement as given in the Purchase Order. National & International material Standards shall have to be arranged by vendors themselves. Negative dimensional tolerance is not allowed. Every dispatch of material shall accompany the packing list, detailing the Numbers of item with specifications. An advance copy of dispatch details shall be furnished to Purchase/BHEL/IVP. The materials are to be dispatched with proper packing and binding.

4. REPLACEMENT OF REJECTION:

If the material is rejected due to defective workmanship during inspection or at the time of actual use, within the guarantee period, the rejected material shall be replaced by the supplier. Corresponding quantity shall be treated as unsupplied against respective purchase order till replacement is received at BHEL. If the material is found defective and rejected during use for which payment has already been released the rejected quantity shall be supplied free of cost by the vendor within a month of intimation of the rejection by BHEL.

Lifting of rejected material is under Supplier's scope. BHEL will inform related invoice, qty etc to supplier. Supplier is expected to give the plan to lift and advance intimation when visiting to lift the material. Material should be lifted within one month from date of intimation. After one month BHEL will not be responsible for rejected material. BHEL may decide to send the rejected material

on To Pay basis to supplier. Any leniency/ unresponsiveness/delay on part of supplier may lead to appropriate action by BHEL. Any request to postpone in written may be considered but replacement should not be linked with lifting of material.

5. DELIVERY SCHEDULE:

Sequence of delivery shall be indicated by BHEL while placing the orders/through other communications. **Vendor shall be required to complete the order as per Purchase orders placed time to time within rate contract period as per monthly CFT commitment.**

6. ACCESS TO MANUFACTURING PREMISES:

While Purchase Orders placed on the vendor are under execution, authorized representatives of BHEL shall be allowed free access to the manufacturing facilities for the purpose of inspection or monitoring the progress of purchase orders. This access will also be extended to representatives of BHEL's customers accompanying the authorized representative/s of BHEL (which shall be intimated in advance), if our contractual requirements with our customers call for the same.

7. TERMS OF PAYMENT:

- a. Due payment against supplies received shall be due after 30 days of receipt and acceptance of material and shall be paid within next 15 days period. In case of any deviation from standard payment term mentioned, BHEL at its discretion may load on the item price at "Base rate of SBI (as applicable on the date of bid opening; Techno-commercial bid opening) + 6% shall be considered for loading for the period of relaxation sought by bidders.
- b. Documents to be submitted
 - i. Commercial invoice (in duplicate)
 - ii. Excise invoice (in duplicate) valid for claiming CENVAT credit
 - iii. Original VAT invoice valid for claiming input tax credit, if applicable
 - iv. Material Test Certificates (MTC) and
 - v. Compliance Certificate.
- c. Above documents should include your Registration numbers such as ECC no, PAN no, CST no, TIN/ VAT nos. etc.
- d. **It is mandatory to mention proper material codes in the invoices and separate invoices to be raised for different POs.**
- e. ***BHEL releases payment through EFT mode ONLY. Necessary details may please be submitted by filling required format before release of payment.***

8. SECURITY DEPOSIT:

An amount equal to 1% of basic value of each invoice shall be deducted from running invoices. Interest free Security Deposit (full or partial after deduction of any amount chargeable from vendor) shall be refunded after completion of order(s) against this tender.

9. INSPECTION:

- a) All required tests as called in referred material standard/BHEL/TDC/drawing etc shall be carried out by vendor at no extra cost. **BHEL may decide to inspect itself/arrange third party at vendors' works itself as and when necessary with prior intimation to the vendor.** No additional charges shall be claimed for such inspections.

- b) Third party inspection charges will be borne by BHEL. Moreover all required infrastructure (testing, tools etc) have to be arranged by supplier.
- c) **Vendor will give inspection call sufficiently in advance considering the delivery period stipulated in the purchase order.**
- d) Material Test Certificates (MTC), Inspection reports and Compliance/Guarantee Certificate are to be provided along with the supplies.
- e) Latest applicable revisions of standards/procedures to be referred. International/National standards are to be arranged by vendor.
- f) Any inspection carried out before supply by vendor/incoming stage at BHEL not withstanding, if any defect/non-conformity is noted during processing, the same shall be attended/replaced by vendor at no extra cost.
- g) Necessary tooling including thread gauges etc have to be arranged by vendor. Only in exceptional cases, based on BHEL discretions item/nature, BHEL may consider request to provide gauges if available with BHEL. But in no case this shall be linked with delivery of material.

10. COUNTER OFFERS

BHEL reserves the right to negotiate with L1 or re-float the tender in case the quoted prices are not acceptable. BHEL will give counter-offer to vendors other than L1, in order to have broader vendors base for ensuring timely delivery. Counter Offers will be given for all items as per loading clause.

11. LOADING

100% Procurement of the tender value shall be made from MSE (Micro, Small Enterprises) firms.

20% from the above mentioned 100% procurement quantity shall be procured from MSE's owned by SC /ST's. If there are more than one MSE's owned by SC /ST's, qty shall be equally divided. Failure to participate by any MSE owned by SC/ST's this 20% quantity shall be procured from other MSEs. All these benefits are subject to production of all statutory documents.

BHEL reserves the right to cancel/ refloat the tender, if the prices are abnormally higher than estimates. Further, BHEL reserve the right to negotiate with L1 vendor and split the tender among bidders to meet its requirement by giving counter offers. If registered vendor is L1, it shall be given minimum of 60% of quantity indicated or its full CFT capacity. BHEL reserves the right to accept/reject any bid for any reason of past performance of bidder.

BHEL reserves the right to give counter-offer to any number of vendors. Loading beyond L1's capacity (or BHEL discretion beyond 60%, as the case may be) shall be done on L2, if it accepts counter-offers. If L2 is not able to take balance load (criteria: minimum of 30% and its capacity), L3 shall be contacted. If L2 does not accept counter-offer, L3 shall be automatically contacted for next loading reserved for L2 and so on. BHEL reserves the right to continue placing orders on any higher bidder who has accepted RC for meeting its requirement, if L1 bidder is new vendor and is taking time for executing development order/any other issue.

BHEL reserves the discretion of deciding loading in any proportion depending upon execution of orders by suppliers and our requirement. Maximum loading to L1 shall be ensured provided despatches are made as committed. BHEL reserves the right of not giving counter-offer to highest bidder.

20% of the tender quantity offered to the MSE's shall be reserved for MSE's owned by SC/STs. In event of failure of such Micro and Small Enterprises to participate in tender process or meet tender

requirements and L1 price, 20 per cent quantity for Micro and Small Enterprises owned by SC/ST entrepreneurs shall be met from other Micro and Small Enterprises.

All above mentioned preferences shall be given to MSEs and SC/STs only on the submission of documentary evidence.

On all vendors who had not supplied material in this category so far to BHEL Goindwal will be given first purchase order of value at Rs. 1 Lakh or upto one month CFT commitment, whichever is lower. The delivery date of Purchase Order shall be kept as 1 month. On successful completion of this purchase order only, further order will be released. This condition is applicable if the vendor is L1 or has accepted counter offer at L1 rates.

12. PENALTY FOR LATE DELIVERY:

Time is the essence of the contract'. As such, delivery of goods specified in the Purchase Orders released under the scope of this contract shall be made within the time limit prescribed therein. Penalty for late delivery will be applicable @ 0.5% per week or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10.0 %.

If any vendor does not accept LD ½% of the supply for each week of delay subject to a maximum of 5%, their offer is likely to be rejected by BHEL and the price bid shall not be opened. Bidders accepting for 10% LD shall not be loaded on account of LD. However bidders who offer any other % LD [between 5% to 10%] shall be loaded @ % deviation from 10% and their accepted %.e.g. If a bidder accepts for a max of 7% LD only, their offer would be loaded @ 3% (10 – 7 = 3).

BHEL reserves the right to receive or not receive the material after the due date of PO.

13. RISK PURCHASE:

BHEL shall be entitled to terminate the contract with any vendor and to purchase elsewhere at the risk and cost of the vendor, either the whole or part thereof which the supplier has failed to deliver within the time stipulated as aforesaid. Vendor shall be liable for the losses, which BHEL may sustain by way of such risk purchase in addition to aforesaid penalty for delayed delivery. Purchases made from any other vendor at its quoted rates shall be made and the difference of rates of defaulter vendor and new vendor shall be deducted from running bills of the vendor who has failed to deliver.

14. SUB-CONTRACT:

The purchase order or any part thereof shall not be sub-contracted, assigned or otherwise transferred without previously obtaining the BHEL's consent in writing.

15. FORCE MAJEURE:

If at any time during the continuance of the contract, the performance in which or in any part by either party of any obligations under the contract are prevented or delayed by reason of any war, hostilities, acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, or acts of God (hereinafter referred to "an events" then provided the notice of happening of any such event is given by either party to the other within 21 days of the occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate the contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance and delay in performance and delivery under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist. If the performance in whole or part of any obligation under the contract is prevented or delayed by reason

of any such event, claims of extension of time shall be granted for periods considered reasonable by BHEL subject to prior notification by the vendor to BHEL of the particulars of the event and supply to BHEL, if required, of any supporting evidence. Any waiver of time in respect of partial installment shall not be deemed a waiver of time in respect of remaining deliveries.

16. DISPUTES:

In the event of any dispute and/or difference arising between the Vendor and BHEL as to interpretation and/or execution of the contract and/or the respective rights and liabilities of the parties, such disputes and/or differences shall be referred to the sole arbitrator nominated by BHEL. The provisions of the Indian Arbitration Act and the rules there under shall apply to such arbitration. The award passed by the arbitrator shall be final and conclusively binding on all the parties.

17. JURISDICTION:

The court of the place from where the purchase order is issued during the contractual period shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of or in connection with the purchase order.

18. MSME & MSE Certification:

If the bidder is registered as any of Micro/Small/Medium enterprise as defined in Micro Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006; a copy of registration certificate to be attached. MSE's shall be given preferences as described in "Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012" subject to the submission of proper documentary evidence (i.e. District Industries Centers or Khadi and Village Industries Commission or Khadi and Village Industries Board or Coir Board or National Small Industries Corporation or Directorate of Handicrafts and Handloom or any other body specified by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises) with quotation. "Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012" document can be downloaded from link <http://dcmsme.gov.in/FinalPressorder.pdf> and can also be collected from the office of DGM/MM IVP Goindwal.

19. CLARIFICATIONS

The correspondence exchanged against the tender from both tenderer and BHEL through email are considered as valid document legally though it is not signed. It is treated as valid confirmations made on behalf of the respective company and very much comes under the legal ambit of the business transaction and hence it is binding on both the parties to the business. Any transaction pertaining to the tender from both the parties of business done round the clock irrespective of the office or business hours of the companies, are valid legally and binding on both the parties. This applies to the extent only in such cases where deadline time for transaction is not specifically declared by either or both the parties to the business.

20. LOI (Letter of Intent)

BHEL may issue LOI prior to the PO for any reason whatsoever. The LOI in such cases is to be treated as PO for all practical purposes and all the Terms & Conditions of the tender shall be applicable from the date of issue of LOI.

21. GENERAL:

- a) BHEL will not be bound by any power of attorney granted by the vendors or by changes in the composition of the firm made subsequent to the execution of the contract. They may,

- however, recognize such power of attorney and changes after obtaining proper legal advice, the cost of which will be chargeable to the vendor concerned.
- BHEL reserves the right to extend the due date of opening, which shall be informed. Validity of offer shall be deemed to be revised accordingly.
 - BHEL reserves the right to accept or reject any part or whole of the tender of a bidder by assigning a valid reason thereof. BHEL reserves the right to cancel the tender without assigning any reason thereof and without any obligation before any commitment.
 - If possible, please submit soft copy of price quotation [copied on a blank CD of standard make] put in the sealed offer.
 - Acceptance of all terms and conditions, in the form of signed copy of T&C or confirmation separately written, shall be submitted along with quotation. If nothing is mentioned, it shall be concluded that terms and conditions are acceptable.
 - BHEL may increase/decrease item/s based on BHEL requirement before price bid opening. Suitable price implication may be asked from suppliers.
 - BHEL may drop item/items from tender at any stage of tender before placing PO. BHEL may also delete PO with consent with supplier within delivery date of PO.
 - After releasing PO, it is assumed that supplier has accepted PO if we do not receive acknowledgement from supplier within 5 days of date of PO.
 - Any term is special tender terms and conditions will supersede the GCC.
 - If advance tax is applicable at Punjab border. Supplier has to deposit this advance tax by himself which will be reimbursed on submission of documentary proofs (Copy of entry tax receipt/online transfer details duly verified).
 - BHEL reserves the right to negotiate with L1 bidder/s.

22. BANNED FIRMS:

The offers of the bidders who are on the banned list as also the offer of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL website www.bhel.com.

23. REVERSE AUCTION

"BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. All bidders to give their acceptance for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

In case BHEL decides to go for Reverse Auction, only those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in RA will be allowed to participate in the Reverse Auction. Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit "online sealed bid" in the Reverse Auction. Terms & Conditions of Reverse Auction

Against this enquiry for the subject item/ system with detailed scope of supply as per enquiry specifications, BHEL may resort to "REVERSE AUCTION PROCEDURE" i.e., ON LINE BIDDING (THROUGH A SERVICE PROVIDER). The philosophy followed for reverse auction shall be English Reverse (No ties).

1. For the proposed reverse auction, technically and commercially acceptable bidders only shall be eligible to participate.
2. Those bidders who have given their acceptance for Reverse Auction (quoted against this tender enquiry) will have to necessarily submit "online sealed bid" in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of „online sealed bid" by the bidder for any of the eligible items for which techno- commercially qualified, will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines in vogue.
3. BHEL will engage the services of a service provider who will provide all necessary training and assistance before commencement of on line bidding on internet.
4. In case of reverse auction, BHEL will inform the bidders the details of Service Provider to enable them to contact & get trained.
5. Business rules like event date, time, bid decrement, extension etc. also will be communicated through service provider for compliance.
6. Bidders have to fax the Compliance form (annexure IV) before start of Reverse auction. Without this, the bidder will not be eligible to participate in the event.
7.
