1. Offer should conform to our Technical Specification and Commercial Terms & Conditions (CTC) without any deviations. Offers with deviation are liable for rejection.
2. Acceptance/Remarks Column of BHEL CTC should be filled against all CTC Clauses, duly Signed, Stamped and submitted with Techno-Commercial Bid (Part-1). The filled in BHEL CTC format submitted with technical bid responding to all the clauses duly signed with seal **only shall be considered**. Any other Commercial Terms & Conditions (CTC) of bidders entered else where in their offer shall not be considered and are liable for rejection.
3. Un-priced price bid format(without price) to be filled and submitted along with Techno-Commercial bid (Part-1) indicating “Quoted” against the respective item/column duly signed and stamped. Un-Priced bid format not complied with the above shall be liable for rejection.
4. All prices should be quoted both in figures & words in the Price Format. In the event of discrepancy between the figures and words in the Price Bid, the amount entered in WORDS only would be taken into consideration for evaluation and finalization of the order.
5. The Tender shall be submitted in Two parts as follows, in separate sealed envelopes super- scribed with Tender Reference and Due date.

PART-1 : Techno-commercial Bid

Technical documents, Documents of Pre-Qualification Criteria, Commercial Terms & conditions with “**accepted**” remark against each clause, Un-priced price bid (without price) indicating “**quoted**” against each item, EMD in separate cover suitably superscribed for identification, all other tender documents etc.,

PART-2 : Price Bid

This shall contain only one document - i.e. Price bid (with price) duly filled in all the columns/items signed and stamped kept in a separate cover and sealed super scribing Tender Ref. and Due date.

The above Two sealed envelopes should be put in another cover. This outer cover should be super-scribed with the Tender Reference Due Date etc. and should reach us latest by 2-00 PM on the specified due date.

6. BHEL reserves the right not to extend the due date for submission of tender against the request of bidders.

15. Bidders who have registered under Micro, Medium and Small Enterprises (MSE`s) are required to submit the valid registration/ownership certificate to avail the benefits as per Government Notification Dated : 23.03.2012.
