1. **QUOTATION:** Each tender should be sent in sealed cover in TWO PARTS with tenderer's distinctive seal and super scribed with correct tender No. Item of supply and due date of opening.


Tenders should be free from CORRECTIONS AND ERASURES: Corrections if any, must be attested. All amounts shall be indicated both in words shall prevail.

2. **TERMS OF PAYMENT:** 100% payment will be made at the end of each quarter duly certified by the user dept.

3. **RISK PURCHASE:** Alternatively the purchaser at this option will be entitled to terminate the contract and to purchase elsewhere at the risk and cost of the seller either the whole of the goods or any part which the supplier has failed to deliver within the time stipulated as aforesaid or if the same were not available, the best and the nearest available substitute therefore. The supplier shall be liable for any loss which the purchaser may sustain by reason of such risk purchases in addition to penalty at the rate mentioned in LD clause above.

4. **LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:** It is clearly among the parties to the contract that time is the essence of the contract. Therefore the delivery of the goods specified, in the purchase order should be made within the time limit prescribed. Where the seller supplies or dispatches the goods beyond the delivery period specified, the purchaser will have no obligation to accept the goods if accepted liquidated damages, at the rate of ½% of the value of goods delayed for each week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of the order value will be levied without prejudice to any other relief or compensation due to the purchaser under any other condition of this contract.

Terms and Conditions

The vendor should accept and adhere all the below mentioned terms and conditions.

1. The contract is for two years from the link commissioning date accepted and certified by BHEL.
2. The 8 mbps 1:1 point to point connectivity should be between A and B ends mentioned below,
A End : Bharat Heavy Electricals Ltd.

B End : BHEL R&D Gateway

3. A technical staff should be nominated by the service provider in order to discuss about the installation and configurations for smooth operations.
4. All equipments required for this connectivity should be supplied and maintained by service provider at both A and B ends.
5. No extra cost will be paid for installation, configuration, commissioning and testing of this 8mbps 1:1 point to point link.
6. All configurations relevant to IPv6 addresses should be done by the service provider as per BHELs requirement in their equipments used for connectivity.
7. The Leased Line connectivity should be terminated at both BHEL locations A and B ends through Fibre Optic connection only and end hand out should be in Ethernet mode.

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8. 24/7 Network Operating Center (NOC) Support & Monitoring should be provided by the service provider as managed client.
9. Bandwidth should be made available on all days including holidays (24/7 365 days).
10. Periodical maintenance of all the components related to the connectivity need to be done and a report has to be submitted along with the quarterly bill.
11. The payment shall be made quarterly after satisfaction of service and the invoices shall be submitted in time at the end of every quarter.
12. After the end of contract, ISP shall extend the contract as per BHEL request and payment shall be made on PRORATA basis as per existing PO value and terms & conditions until new contract been established by BHEL.
13. If required by BHEL, the contract shall be closed prior to actual end date of contract. The vendor should agree for prior closure and provide formal closure acknowledgement to BHEL.
14. Vendor should ensure 98% uptime for this connectivity. Below which deduction will be done from quarterly charges. Deduction will be calculated based on below formula.

$$\text{Deduction} = A \times D \times F$$

Where.

A = Total quarterly charge/ Number of days in a quarterly bill period (Ex : 91 or 92)

D = Downtime in days

F = Deduction Factor
