Technical Delivery Conditions for the Supply of Woods used as Spacers and for Stacking of tubes and Pipes.

1.0 SCOPE :

1.1 This TDC specifies the Quality requirements of woods to be used as Spacers and stacking of tubes and pipes in SSTP.

1.2 The species shall be of Rubber wood - seasoned and chemically treated rubber wood in converted form and it should be confirmed.

2.0 DIMENSIONS :

2.1 Dimensions and descriptions shall be given by indenting department and the same shall be reproduced in the purchase order.

3.0 Tolerance for Dimensions :

3.1 Dimensional tolerance shall be as follows:-

Length	: + 10mm, - 0mm
Width	: + 5mm, - 0mm
Thickness	: + 5mm, - 0mm
Bow tolerance	: 5mm per 500mm subject to maximum of 10mm/metre

3.2 Twist in the woods is not permitted

4.0 Freedom from defects:

4.1 Woods shall be free from common timber defects like cracks, knots etc


5.0 CHEMICAL TREATMENT :

5.1 Supplies shall be subjected to chemical treatment complying with IS 401/1982 - Code of practice for Preservation of timber'.


5.2 For chemical treatment, the preservative chemicals used shall be copper, chrome, boron composition (CCB).

5.3 Chemical penetration depth shall be not less than 3mm when tested as per method given in IS 401/1982.



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6.0 IDENTIFICATION:







5. General:

1. Incomplete Offers shall be liable for rejection.
2. Fixed Price:
Bidder shall quote only Fixed Rate / Price and not subject to any escalation whatsoever during the period of Bid Validity and execution of Purchase Order. Any Bid with adjustable or price variation clause shall be treated as ‘Non-Responsive’ and liable for rejection. Prices shall be written both in numbers and words. In the event of any difference, the price in words shall be valid and binding. Unit Rate shall only be considered as correct and valid, which shall be taken for further consideration.

4. Validity of Offer:

8. BHEL reserves the right:
 1. to increase or decrease the tendered quantity(s) and split such quantities, for all or part of the Enquiry items, among more than one Tenderer based on commitments, requirements and capability of the Vendor(s), and finalise the Tender accordingly.
 2. **to go for Reverse Auction (RA) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. All bidders to give their acceptance for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.**

1. For the proposed reverse auction, technically and commercially acceptable bidders only shall be eligible to participate.
2. Those bidders who have given their acceptance for Reverse Auction (quoted against this tender enquiry) will have to necessarily submit “Online Sealed Bid” in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of “Online Sealed Bid” by the bidder for any of the eligible items for which techno- commercially qualified, will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines in vogue.
3. BHEL will engage the services of a service provider who will provide all necessary training and assistance before commencement of on line bidding on internet.
4. In case of reverse auction, BHEL will inform the bidders the details of Service Provider to enable them to contact & get trained.
5. Business rules like event date, time, bid decrement, extension etc. also will be communicated through service provider for compliance.
6. Bidders have to fax the Compliance form (annexure IV) before start of Reverse auction. Without this, the bidder will not be eligible to participate in the event.
7. In line with the NIT terms, BHEL will provide the calculation sheet (e.g. EXCEL sheet) which will help to arrive at “Total Cost to BHEL” like Packing & forwarding charges, Taxes and Duties, Freight charges, Insurance, Service Tax for Services and loading factors (for noncompliance to BHEL standard Commercial terms & conditions) for each of the bidder to enable them to fill-in the price and keep it ready for keying in during the Auction.
8. Reverse auction will be conducted on scheduled date & time.
9. At the end of Reverse Auction event, the lowest bidder value will be known on auction portal.
