CORRIGENDUM – 02

Sub:-Tender for the work of “Hiring of 2 nos of 20 MT Tower Cranes for Lalitpur Site.”

TENDER NO. BHEL/NR/SCT/LALITPUR/CRANE HIRING/857

The corrigendum contains following amendments (A, B & C) in the specifications and shall be a part of the above tender. This corrigendum is to be submitted, duly signed and stamped, along with the technical bid (Part –I).

A) Qualifying requirement has been changed indicated as below.

1.0 TECHNO-COMMERCIAL CRITERIA

1.1 Bidder should be in the business of Crane Hiring at least for last three years, as on the latest date of bid submission.

OR

The bidder should be in the business of manufacturing of tower cranes & should have manufactured and supplied at least one 20 MT Tower crane during last three years, as on the latest date of bid submission.

1.2 Offered cranes should meet technical specifications of the tender. Bidder to furnish details of the cranes i.e. crane specifications, make of crane along with the load chart and range diagram, proposed to be deployed for the tendered job.

1.3 Bidders shall give undertaking that they will purchase (if Bidder is not owner of the offered crane) and make available the Tower Crane/ Tower Cranes as per the specifications given in the tender enquiry and as per the mobilization schedule given therein. The Bidders shall also undertake that in case they are successful against this tender and order is placed on them, they will provide the crane/cranes, which shall not be more than 7 Years old.

2.0 FINANCIAL CRITERIA

2.1 Bidder should have an average annual turnover of minimum of Rs.300 Lacs (Rupees THREE HUNDREDS LAKHS) during preceding three years (2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11). Bidder shall submit audited annual accounts (balance sheets and profit & loss account) in support of this.

(Relevant documents, meeting above requirements at 1.0 and 2.0, shall be submitted by bidders)

3.0 The bidder is required to enter into an Integrity Pact (I P) with BHEL against this tender / contract by signing and stamping all the pages of IP by authorized representative. Bidders, who do not accept and comply with this requirement, shall not be considered against this tender.

B) Clause no. 3 of TCC may be read as below:-

The Contract Duration Period for Crane Deployment shall be as above, to be reckoned from the date of complete Commissioning and Load Test after Receipt of the Crane with all Accessories at Site in Good Order & Condition, as certified by **BHEL's Site Engineer**. However in case of exigency Site requirement, the schedule is further extendable for Additional months, as indicated above, as per BHEL's discretion, at the same rates and terms & conditions. The monthly rate quoted in the prescribed rate schedule shall remain firm throughout this period including extended period, as above. Terms & conditions including hiring charges for deployment of crane for period beyond Additional Months as indicated above shall be mutually discussed & finalized. However, if the performance of Crane is not satisfactory, the contract shall be liable for termination without prior notice. The Crane with Operator, Helpers and service / maintenance staff shall remain available for minimum cumulative 14 Hours/day inclusive of 1 hour lunch break. The actual deployment date to be coordinated by the contractor with Construction Manager of BHEL's LALITPUR site.

For unloading and Assembly, BHEL shall provide suitable capacity Crane with operator and fuel free of cost.

- C) In view of changes as above, Rate Schedule is being revised as Annexure-A of this Corrigendum. Bidder shall submit their price bid for each crane (i.e. First crane and Second crane) separately in a separate envelope, clearly indicating on cover of the envelop for identification of crane besides furnishing other requisite details. Bidder may submit their offer either for first crane or second crane or both of the cranes as per the respective rate schedule for First crane and Second crane given in this corrigendum. However, Bidders shall specifically confirm in their Part-I bid that they have quoted for one crane or two cranes in the tender**
- D) All other terms and conditions against this NIT shall remain unchanged.**
