- 10.0 Price bids of those bidders will be opened who will be qualified for the subject job on the basis of evaluation of Techno-commercial bids / pre-qualifying criteria and as considered suitable by BHEL.

1. One set of original Manual and reference manual the hardware shall have to be supplied by the vendor.

➤ CERTIFICATES

The vendor will provide following certificates in duplicate along with the equipment at the time of supply : --

- a) Test certificate of equipment .
- b) Warranty certificate.

➤ INSTALLATION & COMMISSIONING

1. Delivery of equipment complete in all respects including manuals as per clause at M/S BHEL'S location including installations and commissioning will be under the scope of vendor. M/S BHEL will ensure the readiness of the location for installation as per the guidelines to be furnished by the vendor within two weeks from the date of receipt of this order.

➤ ACCEPTANCE TEST (ATP):

1. ATP will be started by BHEL with the help of vendor within 7 days after receipt of clear installation certificate issued by the vendor for Hardware . The certificate shall clearly state compatibility of hardware and other items to be supplied under this order. Only this certificate by the vendor will be considered as clear installation certificate and seven days from its date of receipt at BHEL shall be counted for the purpose of commencement of ATP.

ATP shall mean continuous operation of each system for 8 days on 8 hours per day basis. Hardware diagnostics supplied will be run twice a day. Rest of the time real jobs programmes will be run by the actual users. 95% uptime has to be ensured during ATP. If the machine is under breakdown for more than 8 hours continuously then ATP will RESTART from zero hours. After successful completion of ATP the equipment will be deemed to be commissioned.

➤ MAINTENANCE :

During Warranty period :

1. Regular monthly preventive maintenance schedule should be strictly followed.
1. The successful vendor will ensure a minimum uptime of 95% of the System . If the system is not able to perform in accordance with the specifications laid down in the order due to non functioning of the item supplied by the vendor the system will be treated as down.

After Warranty period :

1. After warranty period BHEL reserves the right to opt for third party maintenance or maintenance by the successful vendor.

➤ UPTIME/DOWNTIME

1. Equipment have to be maintained during entire period i.e during entire warranty period & AMC period, in perfect working condition for more than 95% of total working hours in a year. The total working hours will be calculated on the basis of 8 working hours per day.

The Uptime for a year will be calculated as follows

$$\frac{\text{Total Working hrs} - \text{Total Downtime hrs}}{\text{Total Working hrs}} \times 100\%$$

Total working hours = Total nos of BHEL working days for a location in a year X 8.

Counting of the downtime shall be as follows :-

1. Call for equipment malfunction shall be reported by BHEL to ,the service section of the corresponding service location of the vendor. For this purpose vendor will furnish details viz. section's location, office address, phone nos. etc. to BHEL.
2. Time of reporting of all calls shall be within the normal office hours of successful vendor Normal office hours of the vendor to be notified with this offer.
3. All calls reported after 1300 hours on Monday to Friday and after 1000 hours on Saturdays (if Saturday is working day for the successful vendor) shall be treated as a call reported on the next working day for the purpose of down time calculations. Successful vendor shall however make efforts to rectify the problems at the earliest.
4. In case of the system being down for more than 48 Hrs the same may be temporarily replaced by the vendor to ensure continued functioning of the computer systems. The system will be considered up in this case and no down time will be counted. Efforts shall be made to limit such temporary replacements to less than 15 days. However successful vendor will ensure that on any such temporary replacements overall performance of the system will not be affected.

➤ COMPENSATION

1. During warranty period if the system fails to keep the requisite uptime as per UPTIME/DOWNTIME clause then the prorated amount will be from the balance P.O. to be paid after the expiry of the contract as per the following formula. In case 100% payment is made before expiry of warranty period, the warranty shall extend for the period same as the downtime period.
