Section: 2.0. Instructions for Bidding:

Offers are invited from the bidders who have the necessary capabilities, as detailed in this tender document.

In order to execute the contract, the potential bidders shall provide **at least seven Graduates with minimum B.Sc (Chemistry) qualification.**

The contractor shall deploy the above manpower to carry out the contract work within BHEL Factory premises. It is the responsibility of the contractor to ensure the deployment of their manpower on all working days of BHEL.

The day-to-day work shall be carried out, as per the detailed instructions of the Lab In charge.

The required personnel shall have to work in General shift i.e. 08.00 hrs to 16.30 hrs. In contingencies, the personnel shall have to work in extended hours also.

The contractor shall provide the rate for each sample tests and arrive at the total sum for all the tests for all the samples. The contract will be awarded for the lowest bidder based on Grand Total of all the three types of testing (Coal, Ash and Deposit Testing).

While quoting, the wages to be paid as per BHEL norms (Annex. I), over and above the prescribed minimum wages by Government of Tamilnadu (Annex. II) has to be taken into account.

The payment for each month will be made based on the number of tests completed.

The Standard Conditions of BHEL for any outsourcing contract as given in Annexure III & IV shall be binding.

CIRCULAR

Sub : Additional Payment to Contract Workmen over and above the T.N. Government Minimum Wages and Payment of Central Government Minimum Wages - Reg.

Vide Circular dated 16/8/2011, all the contract awarding/executing executives were requested to ensure additional payment of Rs.2000/2300/2500 over and above Minimum Wages prescribed by the Government of Tamil Nadu. We still find that contracts are released without specifying the additional amount. Further, the Labour Enforcement Officer (Central) has issued directions to ensure payment of Central Government Minimum Wages to contract workmen. Non- payment of additional amount in terms of Circular dated 16/8/2011 also results in deficient payment i.e. less than Central Government Minimum Wages.

Hence, in order to streamline the payment of additional amount as per corporate guidelines and to ensure appropriate minimum wages, the following points are circulated to all contract awarding departments for implementation with immediate effect :

I. Contracts where additional amount applicable :

1. Contracts where State Govt., Minimum Wages plus Additional Amount of Rs.2000/2300/2500 is already specified, the same shall continue at the same rates.
2. In running contracts where additional amount is not specified but applicable as per our Circular, the same shall be taken up for revision of contract value by the respective departments.

Further, in these contracts, if supervisors are also engaged, then additional amount of Rs.2500 shall be payable to them over and above the State Government Minimum Wages .

II. Contracts where Schedule of Rates applicable :

In Contracts where Schedule of Rates are available like Civil Construction Contracts, the Additional Amount is not applicable. Hence, the Central Government Minimum Wages shall be implemented and necessary amendment to this effect shall be made in the running as well as future contracts/tenders.

In a nut shell, except Contracts based on Schedule of Rates, all other contracts shall be executed as per Circular dated 16/08/2011 i.e., State Government Minimum Wages plus Additional Amount. In case of Contracts based on Schedule of Rates, payment of Central Government notified Minimum Wages shall be ensured.

All Contract Awarding/Executing Executives shall take careful note of the above and ensure that no contracts shall be executed or entered without incorporating any one of the above stated applicable conditions.

The contract will be awarded for a period of 2013-2015 from the date of LOI. Minimum wages as stipulated by the Government from time to time should at least be paid to the personnel in the presence of BHEL Executive. The rates are firm for the entire period of contract. The contractor should deposit a sum of **Rs.60,000/- (Rupees Sixty Thousand only)** as **EMD by means of Demand Draft drawn in favour of BHEL, Tiruchirappalli**. Offers will not be considered if EMD is not enclosed along with the quotation. EMD amount will be forfeited if bidder withdraws his offer within the validity period or revises his rates and also when the successful bidder is not commencing the work within the time stipulated in the contract.

In the event of placement of contract, bills should be submitted by the contractor as per the number of tests performed along with the certification from the executing agency. The bills for payment will be reviewed by **AGM/CRC** and the bills will be passed for payment by **AGM /CRC** only on production of documents (including the PF and ESI statement vouched by BHEL Welfare Department, indicating the names of the employees, their PF/ESI account number and the amount credited and a copy of the challan of previous month service tax paid as a proof of deposit of service tax along with a self certified letter stating that the tax collected from BHEL has been remitted to tax authorities.) for having complied with Statutory requirement applicable for the personnel. The conditions contained herein, the conditions as given in Annexure IV and statutory requirement imposed by the Government authorities from time to time will be part and parcel of this contract. The EMD of the successful bidder shall be converted to Security Deposit (SD). The SD shall be arrived as per the Contract Value and 50% thereon shall be paid by the contractor before the Commencement of Work

10% of the bill amount will be withheld towards balance 50 % of the security deposit and on satisfactory performance, security deposit will be returned. EMD will be returned to the unsuccessful bidders on finalisation of contract.

Bidders shall sign each and every page of the tender documents and affix seal for having accepted the conditions.

Conditions covering the Contract:

1. The contractor shall pay minimum wages to his labourers as per Tamil Nadu govt. latest circular. Any revision arises within one year period, it is the contractors responsibility to pay the revised min. pay as per norms.
2. The contractor shall pay additional wages also as per Corporate guidelines (Annexure-I) along with TN Govt. wages.
3. Contractor shall maintain attendance and acquaintance Registers and submit copies every month for both TN Govt. wages and additional wages
4. The contractor shall pay Bonus to their employees as per minimum bonus act, for both TN Govt. wages and additional wages (8.33% /one month pay)
5. The contractor shall remit PF and ESI (for both TN Govt. wages and additional wages) for the actual labourers engaged and produce the original challan every month along with bill for our verification and record.
6. The contractor shall produce a copy of the challan of previous month sevice tax paid as a proof of deposit of service tax along with a self certified letter stating that the tax collected from BHEL has been remitted to tax authorities.
7. The contractor shall not employ anyone who has not completed 18 years of age.
8. The contractor shall comply with all state and central laws, statutory rules, and regulations, labour and industrial laws, income tax, service tax etc. which are applicable from time to time. (Contractors without Service Tax number need not bid the contract)
9. Any increase in minimum wage by Tamil Nadu Government, shall be implemented by the contractor (including PF & ESI). For any reason, no increase in contract value shall be agreed by BHEL.
10. Power, machinery and stationeries, etc. will be supplied by BHEL, Trichy.
11. The contractor should bring their workforce.
12. All safety equipmentare to be provided by the contractor to the workmen. The safety rules & regulations are to be followed as per BHEL's Safety rules & regulations.
13. It is the sole responsibility of the contractor to ensure his workmen against accident and injury while at work. They have to follow relevant pay compensation rules in case of accident/injury. BHEL, Trichy is in no way responsible for any loss of life or any injury caused to any of the contractors and their crew while executing the above work at our premises.
14. The contractor or his crew should handle the machinery and other equipment entrusted to them by BHEL, Trichy with utmost care and return them safely after execution of stipulated work. The cost of damage / repair due to improper handling of machinery and equipment will be recovered from the contractor.
15. BHEL, Trichy reserves the right to alter any of the terms & conditions of the contract and any such changes will be intimated to the contractor from time to time.
16. BHEL, Trichy reserves the right to cancel / terminate the contract at any time without assigning any reason.

17. The contractor should maintain a 'Work Diary' containing the details of work executed by him from time to time on daily basis and obtain the signature from official concerned nominated for this purpose for having executed the work correctly to our satisfaction.
18. The proof of execution of work should be submitted along with each bill (printed form with covering letter and proof for execution of work).
19. The bill should be submitted within the month end after execution of work during the calendar month and only one bill per month.
20. Necessary gate entry pass will be issued by BHEL Security Department on CRC Lab recommendation for the workforce and Security Rules are to be observed strictly by them.
21. The contractor shall be responsible for the proper behavior and observing all rules and regulations by the labour employed by them.
22. BHEL rules will be applicable towards issue of refreshments /food which will be adhered by the contractor. As per existing procedure for Canteen facilities, the lunch coupon shall be issued @ Rs.5 (Rs. Five) per person. Sufficient and valid coupons are to be tendered for Tiffin, Tea, Coffee, Milk, etc. to the canteen staff. Rarely, if food could not be provided by BHEL due to administrative reasons, the contractor shall provide food to their labourers.
23. The contract labourers should not indulge in any mass strike within CCDP/WRI/BHEL or strike outside CCDPWRI/BHEL gate. If any such things happen, BHEL has the right to terminate the contractor and all payments will not be paid.

CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. DEFINITION:

In these Conditions of Contract, the following terms shall have the meaning hereby assigned to them, except where the context otherwise requires:

- a. The "Contract" means, the documents forming the tender and acceptance thereof, together with all the documents referred to therein including general and special conditions to contract. All these documents as applicable taken together shall be deemed to form one contract and shall be complementary to one another.
- b. The "work" means, the work described in the tender documents in individual work orders as may be issued from time to time to the contractor by the Officer-In charge within the power conferred upon him including all notified or additional items of works and obligations to be carried out as required for the performance of contract.
- c. The "contractor" means, the individual Firm or Company whether incorporated or not, undertaking the work and shall include the legal personal representatives of such individuals or the persons composing the firm or Company or the successors of the firm or company and the permitted assigns of such individual or firm or Company.
- d. "The Officer-In charge" means, the Officer deputed by the **AGM / CRC** to supervise the work or part of the work.
- e. **"Approved" and "Directed" means, the approval or direction of AGM /CRC, or person deputed by him for the particular purposes.**
- f. **"BHARAT HEAVY ELECTRICALS LIMITED"** (hereinafter referred to as BHEL) shall mean the Board of Directors, Chairman, Executive Director, General Manager or, other Administrative Officer of the said Company including DGM/CRC authorised to invite tenders and enter into contract for works on behalf of the Company.
- g. The "Contract sum" means, the sum accepted or the sum calculated in accordance with the prices accepted in tender and / or the contract rates as payable to the contractor for the execution of the work during the currency of the contract.
- h. A "week" means, Seven Days, without regard to the number of hours worked or not worked in any day in that week.
- i. **A "day" means, the day of 24 hours (TWENTY-FOUR) irrespective of the number of hours worked or not worked in that day.** A "working day" means, any day other than that prescribed by the **NEGOTIABLE INSTRUMENTS ACT** as being a Holiday, and consists of the number of hours of labour as commonly recognised by good employers in

the trade in the District where the work is carried out or as laid down in the BHEL regulations.

2. HEADING TO THE CONTRACT CONDITIONS: - The heading to these conditions shall not affect the interpretations thereof

3. WORK TO BE CARRIED OUT: - The Contract shall include all labour which may be required for the execution of the work.

The Contractor will be deemed to have satisfied himself as to the nature of the site, local facilities of access and all matters affecting the execution of the work. No extra charges consequent on any misunderstanding in these respects or otherwise will be allowed.

4. DEVIATIONS: The contractor shall carry out the work covered in Scope of work in as per instructions of Executing official without any deviations.

5. MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR A CONTRACTOR: The contractor shall have a minimum of one year experience in arranging skilled labour for laboratory/industry prior to submission of the bid for this job. The contractor shall submit a certificate from one of the customers for having executed the above job.

6. LABOUR QUALIFICATION: The contractor shall undertake the analytical works by providing man power with adequate experience as per the following terms and conditions for the execution of the works detailed in the contract:

- a. The contractor shall employ at least seven graduates with minimum B.Sc. Chemistry qualification, of which minimum of 70 % of the personnel shall have previous experience for at least 6 months in a laboratory. The contractor shall provide a compliance certificate in this regard.
- b. The eligibility or experience of the individuals for executing the analytical works in the particular areas as specified in the contract shall be based on a subjective evaluation by senior executives of **Coal Research/ BHEL**.
- c. The evaluation method shall be an oral interview or a written exam consisting of objective type questionnaire related to the fields of previous experience.
- d. The final decision of accepting eligible candidate lies with **AGM / CRC**.

7. ASSIGNMENT OF TRANSFER OF CONTRACT: - The Contractor shall not, without the prior written approval of the BHEL, assign or transfer the contract or any part thereof, or any share, or interest thereon to any other persons. No sum of money which may become payable under the contract shall be payable to any person, other than the contractor unless the prior written approval of the BHEL to the assignment or transfer of such money is given.

8. SUB-CONTRACT: - The Contractor shall not sublet any portion of the contract without the prior written approval of the BHEL.

9. COMPLIANCE TO REGULATIONS AND BYELAWS: - The Contractor shall conform to the provisions of any statute relating to the work and regulations and Byelaws of any local authority. The Contractor shall be bound to give all notices required by Statutory regulations or by-laws as aforesaid and to pay all fees and taxes payable to any authority in respect thereof.

10. SECURITY DEPOSIT: -Security Deposit should be paid by the contractor. The Security Deposit rate will be as follows:

- a. Up to Rs.10.00 lakhs - 10% of Work Order Value
- b. Above Rs. 10.00 lakhs up to Rs. 50.00 lakhs - Rs. 1 lakh + 7.5% of the amount exceeding Rs. 10 lakhs
- c. Above Rs. 50 lakhs: Rs 4 lakhs + 5 % of the amount exceeding Rs. 50 lakhs

The Earnest Money paid at the time of tender will be adjusted as part of the Security Deposit to a level of 50% of contract value before start of the work and the balance amount recovered by deduction from the running bills of the contractor at the rates mentioned above.

Security Deposit shall not be refunded except in accordance with the terms of Security Bond or Agreement. Security Deposit may be furnished in anyone of the following terms:

- i. Cash,
- ii. Call Deposit receipt, Pay Order, Demand Draft duly pledged in favour of BHEL.
- iii. Post Office cash certificate, National Savings. Certificates, Treasury Savings Deposit Certificates, National Plan Savings Certificates, 12 Years National Defence Certificates and 10 Years Defence Deposit certificates.
- iv. Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by State Bank of India / Nationalised Banks.
- v. Insurance Guarantee issued by LIC or any of the four General Insurance Corporations.

- vii. Bank Guarantee shall be accepted to a value of 50% of the calculated Security Deposit amount only and 50% of Security Deposit shall be in anyone of the forms as mentioned above from S.No. (i to vi).
- viii. The Bank Guarantee shall be kept valid until the due date for refund of Security Deposit.

25. However no such recovery shall be enforced after three years of passing the final bill.

26. REFUND OF SECURITY DEPOSIT: - The Security Deposit mentioned in condition 8 above may be refunded to the Contractor after a period of 6 months on termination or expiry of the contract provided always that the Contractor shall first have been paid the last and final bill and have rendered a "**NO DEMAND CERTIFICATE**".

27. FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE: -If, at any time during the continuance of this Contract the performance in whole or in part by either party of any obligations under this Contract shall be prevented or delayed by reason of any War, Hostile acts of the public enemy Civil Commotion, Epidemics, or Acts of God (Floods, Storm/Cyclone, Hurricane, Earthquake etc.) then provided notice of happening of any such event is given by either party to other within 7 days from the date of occurrence therefore neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate this Contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance and delay in performance under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist.
