Sealed tender are invited in two-bid system for De Shafting of rotor from the following rotors:

- i) De-shafting of Rotor - Quantity 1 No. (3863-01)
Core Length – 400mm
Total Shaft Length – 2900mm
Core Outer Diameter: 807mm
Shaft core dia – 270mm & 268mm approx. (step shaft)
- ii) De-shafting of Rotor - Quantity 1 No. (3863-02)
Core Length – 400mm
Total Shaft Length – 3090mm
Core Outer Diameter: 987mm
Shaft core dia – 340mm & 339mm approx. (step shaft)

1. Technical Terms & conditions:

- 1.1 The shaft should be removed by machining / on hydraulic press as feasible.
- 1.2 The scrap to be retained by the vendor. The scrap value should be considered in submitting the offer.

2. Acceptance Norms:

- 2.1 After removing the shaft, the internal core should be free from any burrs so that re-shafting is free.
- 2.2 Vendor shall obtain BHEL's Clearance before dispatching the materials at Stores.



Date to be reckoned for determining the deemed validity will be the last date of technical bid submission. Non submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bids at par with other bidders and MSE status of such suppliers shall be shifted to Non MSE suppliers till the supplier submits these documents.”

- 2) Final evaluation shall be carried out after considering CENVAT/VAT / Service Tax credit available to BHEL.

1. COMMERCIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1.1 Price:** Price should be quoted strictly as per proforma for price bid, FOR destination (EMRP Mumbai) basis Inclusive of transportation,
- For bid evaluation, price will be calculated on the basis of landed cost to BHEL as per the price Proforma for each rotor.
- 1.2 Validity of Offer:** Your offer should be valid for a period of 60days from the date of opening of techno-commercial bid including extensions.
- 1.3 Delivery Period:** The delivery will be within 04 weeks for each rotor. The delivery period will be considered from the date of issue of rotors.
- 1.4 Delivery Place:** Free delivery to our stores at BHEL, EMRP, MIDC Andheri (E), Mumbai – 400 093.
- 1.5 Price Variation Clause:** Price offered should be firm till the delivery of de-shafts rotors (full qty).
- 1.6 Late Delivery / Penalty Clause:** L.D @ 0.50% per week shall be deducted from the bill subject to 10% of the basic price, if the material is not delivered within the contractual delivery schedule, L.D. will be applicable for the undelivered portion beyond delivery schedule and not on the total quantity.
- 1.7 Transportation:** Transportation is in the vendor's scope .Vendor has to collect the rotors from our works and deliver the same after de-shafting to our works. The prices should be inclusive of transportation cost. However, if vendor choose to quote transportation charges separately, same should be done in the price bid.
- 1.8 Packing & Forwarding:** The rotors should be safely transported to avoid any damage. Packing if required is in the vendor's scope.
- 1.9 Payment Terms:** Our payment terms are 90 days from the date of completion of the work and receipt of material at our works (45 days fro MSMED vendors covered under the act)(refer Annexure-A)
- a) Payment will be made through e-payment only. Vendor should furnish bank details if not submitted earlier.
 - b) Progressive payment can be made after deduction of LD if any as and when the material is received and accepted in our stores.
- 1.10 Taxes & Duties:** Bidders to clearly specify the taxes and duties applicable on the date of submission of offer. However, any statutory variation in the rates and taxes and duties after the date of submission shall be considered and actual rates applicable at the time of dispatch of material shall be payable at actual against documentary evidence.
- 1.11 Transit Insurance:** Material will be insured by vendor.
- 1.12 Inspection:** BHEL will inspect the material at vendor's work before dispatch.

1.13 Evaluation Criteria: Price evaluation shall be done on the basis of landed cost of each item.

1.14 Octroi charges: In vendors scope as applicable.

2 PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF TENDER

2.1 Bidder shall submit the offer in two bid system in two different sealed covers.

2.2 Part 'A': Techno-Commercial Bid

2.3 Part 'B': Price Bid

2.4 **Tender No., date and due date of opening should be written on both the covers.**

2.5 These two covers shall then be placed in a large cover and sealed. The large cover should also have Tender no., Date and Due Date. This should be dropped in the tender box placed at the entrance of our works before due date and time.

2.6 **Part 'A' - Techno Commercial Bid:** Techno Commercial Bid shall contain technical and commercial offer as per NIT Proforma, indicating acceptance of NIT terms, as per Annexure-I. Acceptance of all technical and commercial terms and conditions given in the format Annexure I. (No Deviation certificate and deviation Proforma), duly filled in signed as required. Blank Price Bid Proforma indicating only the rates of taxes and duties applicable, without rate / price for material, should be enclosed with the techno-commercial bid Part A.

2.7 **Part 'B':** Price Bid Part B should contain only the price duly filled in Price Bid Proforma Annexure II, **without any terms and conditions.** Any terms and conditions, if mentioned in the price bid, shall be ignored and not considered.
