## QUALIFICATION CRITERIA

- a) The bidder should have executed Structural steel work, fabrication and erection works in Power plants or Steel plants or Refineries or Petrochemical projects in the last 7 years.

and

Bidder should have executed structural steel fabrication of 6500MT in a year in a single Project.

**Note:** The word “Executed” means that the bidder should have completed the quantum of work mentioned above even if the total contract is not completed / closed. The same shall be supported by documentary evidence issued by the owner / client.

- b) The bidder should have a minimum average financial turn over of

**Rs. 12.6 crores** in the last three financial years ending **31<sup>st</sup> March 2008**.

The bidders must have earned profit in any one of the last three financial years ending **31 03 2008** and should have positive net worth as on 31.03.2008.

The bidders should submit audited balance sheet and profit and loss account of the company along with all connected schedule / notes forming part of Balance Sheet audited for the last three years ending 31 03 2008 in support of the above requirement.

- c) Notwithstanding the above, BHEL reserves right to reject any tender or all the tenders for the reasons whatsoever beyond our control and decision of BHEL is final.
- d) Approval of the agency by Customer.

Tenders are to be submitted strictly in accordance with the tender specifications and special instructions as given.

**The format ( FORM- iii) showing the experience in the works as called in the Pre qualifying requirement must be filled and also to be supported with documents like certificates issued by clients / end users.**

**The format should not be left blank or mentioned as “enclosed separately”. Enclosing the company’s booklet / leaflet / self certification in lieu of the above is strictly not acceptable**

The tender offer should be kept valid for **180** days from the date of **bid** opening for acceptance by BHEL. No unsolicited revision in the tender offer shall be entertained after opening of tenders till the expiry of the validity period.

**NOTE:**

BHEL reserves the right to adopt the process of **Reverse Auction** (on line bidding) among the bidders who are found to be qualified on the basis of Technical bid.

The process for Reverse Auction will be made available in the web as a corrigendum to this tender and the confirmation to this effect will be advertised through the press notification in a week’s time. No extension of time on this account will be entertained for bid submission.

**MODE OF AWARD OF WORK FOR UNIT 1 & UNIT 2**

- i) There are two units of 600MW each at North Chennai. Tender SCT 1324 is for unit 1 - 600MW (at North Chennai) only. The quantity indicated in the price bid is for Unit-1 only.
- ii) The L1 bidder against this quote will be awarded the contract for Unit 1 of North Chennai TPP - 600MW.
- iii) However, BHEL reserves the right to award the contract for Unit 2 at North Chennai, on the same terms and conditions of SCT 1324, to the next lowest bidder in the order of competitiveness who should match his rates / price with L1 bidder of unit 1.
- iv) Thus the work will be awarded to two agencies i.e. Unit 1 work for one agency and Unit 2 work for another agency
- v) Each unit will be treated as a separate contract.
- vi) Refer Cl. 24.0 in the Special condition of contract for the mode of award of work for Unit 1 & 2.
