PRE – QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS (PQR) FOR BOIs.

Requirements Applicable For Portable Lube Oil Purifier (PLOP).

1. The offered equipment should have been designed & manufactured in conformance to applicable Indian/ International standards.
2. The vendor should
 - (i) Own design/ engineering establishment & testing facilities with experienced personnel in the field and well established quality systems to control & monitor the quality of manufactured and outsourced equipment as well as for project management and execution facilities.
 - (ii) In case the vendor does not have experience of having supplied the offered equipments/ systems on its own strength then the vendor can collaborate/ associate with a party/ vendor having the experience and meeting the qualifying requirement stipulated above. In that case the vendor would have to give a joint deed of undertaking with his collaborator/ associate toward back up guarantee for the product on the project specific basis.
 - (iii) Furnish minimum two (02) nos. of feedback certificates from end user of capacity about 500-1000 LPH, working satisfactorily at a Thermal Power plant of unit rating 125 MW or above for last two years. Feedback certificate from end user shall not be more than 5 year old as on date of offer submission.
 - (iv) Furnish the experience list of PLOPs, supplied only for Power Plants,
3. The End Customer viz. RRVUNL (Rajasthan Rajya Vidyut Utpadan Nigam Ltd.) for the Suratgarh STPS, apart from stipulations indicated in general PQR, has following additional aspects, regarding performance feedbacks (with reference to point 2 above) to be complied by the bidders :
 - i) Atleast one no. Satisfactory Performance feedback Certificate from End User as submitted by Bidder shall be for the equipment which has been working satisfactory for Two (2) years as on or before 03.12.2012. Date of certificate must be in between year 2007 to 2012.
 - ii) Documents to show that the equipment has been supplied by the bidder for power plant of minimum unit rating of 500MW and above.

Note :

The bidders, who are already registered with BHEL PEM without any Technical limit, need not submit Technical PQR under sl. No. 1 & 2.
However, every bidder is required to submit documents / certificate as mentioned under sl. No. 3.
