

**CHP&AHP Project for 1040 MW Power Plant ,HNPCL VIZAG  
PART – A, TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF DISTRIBUTION BOARDS  
Bidders Eligibility and Criteria for Acceptance of Bid**

**1. Bidders Eligibility**

- i) Bidder should have been manufacturing distribution boards atleast for the past five years (to be reckoned from date of Tender date) .
- ii) Bidder shall furnish copy of purchase Orders from at least two major industries like Steel plants/ power plant customers where such distribution boards have been supplied.
- iii) The Bidder Should be financially sound. The bidder should have manufactured for order values of at least Indian Rs. 1 Crore ( Rupees One Crore) .
- iv) In case Bidder is registered with any of the BHEL units, same has to be furnished along with offer.

**2. Mandatory Information/ Documents to be furnished by bidder along with technical offer without which offer is liable for rejection.**

- i. Eligibility papers as listed above.
- ii. Brief Profile of the Company.
- iii. Reference List with specific details of purchase order if any for BHEL .

**The Bidder shall clearly explain his capability in this regard in his offer.**

**Unless BHEL is satisfied about suppliers capability the offer may be rejected.**

**3. Criteria for Bid Acceptance.**

- i) The offer acceptance is subjected to *customer's approval, for the supplier/makes of major components employed .*
- ii) The Price -Bids of the customer approved bidders only shall be opened.
- iii) "Deviation format" shall be duly filled by the bidders and incase of any deviation shall be clearly mentioned in the deviation format.

Hence even if BHEL finds any bid technically and commercially acceptable, the same may be rejected due to non-acceptance by customer.

**4. General Guidelines for Bid Evaluation.**

- i) The bid with any deviation either in commercial conditions or with respect to technical part of the Tender cannot be accepted. Also Bid with any additional conditions stipulated by supplier in his offer cannot be accepted. The supplier needs to confirm "No deviation" and must ensure that all items in Price format are quoted. The supplier is advised to submit an un-priced copy of the Price Bid for verification during technical bid evaluation, before opening of the price bids. The bidder has to confirm the same by mentioning "QUOTED" against each item. Hence bidder has to take all the technical clarifications and consider them for submitting the offer.

Any comments or deviation mentioned by supplier in sealed price Bid shall be ignored. If it is found at later stage (after acceptance of Bid ) that the supplier has not quoted his price against any specific works /item in the price format it will be considered that cost of the particular works /item is included in the Total cost of the Bid.

- ii) The supplier cannot submit revised price-Bid unless BHEL issues any specific amendment to Tender and price format is specifically revised. The bidder is advised not to leave any item of price format un-quoted, to avoid rejection of the offer.

**Note: The Bidder must go through the Tender Documents in complete. Without EMD and Commercial Terms & Conditions duly filled Up the Bid is liable for outright rejection.**
