SUB: TENDER FOR EXECUTION AND HANDING OVER OF CIVIL WORKS FOR
220 KV SUBSTATION AT SIKKA IN GUJARAT.

Sealed Tenders (Under two part bid system) are invited from competent civil contractors for execution and handing over of Civil works of 220 KV Substation at Sikka in Gujarat. Only those who are technically and financially capable to execute the Job and who fulfil the Qualifying Requirements [QR] given under are eligible to quote against the above NIT. Tenderers should submit their offer in a sealed envelope as per the procedure specified in tender documents. The QR of contractor for tender submission shall be as under:

- a. Vendors should have a minimum average annual turnover of Rs. 185 lakh for last three financial years ending on 31.03.07. Vendor should submit audited balance sheet and Profit & Loss Account for last three years ending on 31.03.07.
- b. Vendor should have successfully executed/executing similar job (s) (ref note below) during last seven years ending 31.07.08. Vendor should produce Certification/proof in support of execution/executing similar package from User/end user and should be either of the following:
 - i. **Three similar jobs completed/ executing works each costing not less than Rs 247 lakh.**
 - OR
 - ii **Two similar jobs completed /executing works each costing not less than Rs. 308 lakh**
 - OR
 - iii **One similar job completed/ executing work costing not less than Rs. 493 lakh.**
- c. Vendor should have earned profit in at least one year during last three financial years ending on 31.03.07.

NOTE: Similar job shall mean successful executed/executing of civil works of switchyard or substation or power house or industry/infrastructure predominantly concrete work.

Quotations received from bidders who do not fulfil the QR shall be summarily rejected without any further evaluation and information to bidders.

Important Notes

- 1) BHEL reserves the right to:
 - (a) Accept or reject any bid received at its discretion without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
 - (b) Postpone the dates mentioned in the NIT, split and distribute the work among more than one bidder without assigning any reason whatsoever.
 - (c) May ask for further qualification during techno commercial scrutiny of bids received.
- 2) BHEL shall not be responsible for any delay, loss, damage for bids sent by post.
- 3) BHEL shall not be liable for any expenses incurred by bidder in preparation of bid irrespective of whether it is accepted or not.
- 4) Canvassing i.e. soliciting favour, seeking advantage etc. in any form is strictly prohibited and any bidder found to have engaged in canvassing shall be liable to have his bid rejected summarily.
- 5) If the bidder deliberately gives any wrong information in his tender to create in circumstances for the acceptance to his bid, BHEL reserves the right to reject such application.
