1.0 SCOPE OF WORK:

1.1.1 Specification For DG set: Silent type 415 / 440 V, 3 Phase 4 wire – 50 Hz., 250 KVA DG set complete with control panel, change over switch and inter connecting system cables

a) DG set should be provided with Operators & maintenance staff and should be in good working condition

b) These D G sets shall be used as power backup, when there is power failure and not for continuous use. These sets should not be more than 2 years old. Documentary proof of owning these DG sets and are not more than 2 (two) years old, to be submitted along with offer.

1.2 These DG sets should be available for 24 hrs. in a day with two operators. These DG sets are required as a power back-up in case of power failure while welding work is in process and may or may not used in a day. All required consumables and spares should be available in sufficient quantity along with maintenance staff. **Fuel shall be provided by BHEL.** Separate rate for mobilization and demobilization to be quoted as indicated in rate schedule.

2.0 DEPLOYMENT DETAILS, CONTRACT PERIOD AND DAILY WORKING HOURS

The Contract Duration Period for DG set Deployment shall be as above, to be reckoned from the date of complete Commissioning and Receipt of the DG set with all Accessories at Site in Good Order & Condition, as certified by **BHEL's Site Engineer of Respective site**. However in case of exigency Site requirement, the schedule is further extendable for Additional Months (As indicated above) or can be closed earlier depending upon actual Site requirement **with minimum One (1) Month's notice period in advance for respective site**. The monthly rate quoted in the prescribed rate schedule shall remain firm throughout this period including extended period (if any). However, if the performance of DG set is not satisfactory the contract shall be liable for termination without prior notice. The DG set with Operator, Helpers and service / maintenance staff shall remain available for full month for 24 hrs in a day without any holiday including Sundays. The actual deployment date to be coordinated by the contractor with Construction Manager, BHEL Site Office of respective Sites.

3.0 SCHEDULE OF DG SET MOBILIZATION & LOCATION

The tentative deployment schedule of the DG sets is as indicated in the Clause 2.0. Actual requirement shall be given by Construction Manager of respective site based on site conditions. However the DG set with all Accessories, operators, helper etc. shall have to be transported & physically mobilized to BHEL **Respective Sites within a period of 15 DAYS from the date of notice by Construction Manager**.

Note:- BHEL intent to deploy these DG sets at the sites indicated above however final deployment to sites other than the above sites shall be decided by BHEL as per requirement at the time of placing order. Contractor has to indicate per Km rates for mobilization and demobilization in case these DG sets are to be deployed other than site indicated above in price bid under optional item rate.

4.0 RATE SCHEDULE

Separate Rates for i) Monthly Rental of the DG Set inclusive of **all lubricants, grease, spare parts, filters , consumables, operators, helper Maintenance staff etc.** based on the working hours as above and ii) Mobilization and Demobilization Charges together for the DG set to & from Site are to be quoted separately in the enclosed Price Schedule Format of this Tender. **For recording the hours of operation with engine on condition, vendor is required to maintain a separate register at site, which shall be certified by site engineer.** The quoted rates shall remain firm throughout the entire contract tenure including extension if any. The rates quoted shall be inclusive of all taxes and duties, excluding service tax and educational cess, which shall be reimbursed separately against invoice. There is no provision for any Advance Payment by BHEL for Mobilization/Demobilization etc.

4.1 Contractor shall fully understand equipment description and scope of work before quoting. The scope of work and responsibility of the contractor as mentioned under these specifications shall be covered within the quoted rates.

- 4.2 The tenderer shall quote the rates as per the rate schedule only, in part II price bid (Original). Conditional price bids or price bids with any deviation / clarification etc. are liable to be rejected. No cutting / erasing / over writing shall be done.
- 5.0 The DG set Operation shall be executed under the usual conditions prevailing in major power plant construction and in conjunction with numerous other operations at Site. The contractor and his personnel shall co-operate with all BHEL personnel, BHEL's Customer, Customer's Consultants and all other Contractors, coordinating with others and work in a manner that shall not delay or hinder the progress of work of the project.
- 6.0 The contractor shall execute the work in most substantial and workman like manner.
- 7.0 Mobilization Charges for the DG set shall be paid only after satisfactory commissioning of the DG set at Site, and certification from BHEL Site to this effect.
- 8.0 Demobilization charges shall be paid only on receipt of written confirmation from BHEL site that the DG set has been dismantled and transferred from the site by the vendor.
- 9.0 All Safety norms as required shall be strictly followed.
- 10.0 Operation, Maintenance and All Consumables required for regular daily running of the DG set as per the working hours mentioned are to be provided by the Contractor. The agency should provide adequate nos. of Operators, Helpers and Maintenance personnel to ensure Trouble-free uninterrupted Operation, Services and Maintenance of the DG set at Site. In case the Contractor fails to provide the required Consumable except fuel etc. in time, BHEL reserves the right to supply the same and deduct the Cost from Contractor's Bill with 30% overheads.
- 11.0 Normally the Maintenance/Greasing activities in the DG set shall be done by the Contractor during Recess Period so that no working day is lost for outage of the DG set. However, any Breakdown/Repair of the DG set shall be immediately attended by contractor at his own cost & risk. The contractor is to maintain stock of adequate Spares & Consumables with the required Tools & Tackles at Site for this purpose.
- 12.0 A Log book giving full operation/maintenance/downtime if any details shall be maintained by the Contractor at Site and regularly endorsed by the BHEL Site Engineer through his signature on daily basis or as per the site procedure.
- 13.0 In case of operator's absence the contractor shall arrange alternative immediately for continuation of Site work so as not to hamper the time scheduled of erection programme.
- 14.0 If the DG set becomes idle due to failure attributable to it's own mechanism due to whatsoever reason, the idle hours for making the DG set ready will be deducted

- from the monthly hire charges on pro-rata basis of the accepted monthly lump sum hiring rate.
- 15.0 In case there is a total failure of the DG set due to any reason whatsoever, the contractor should replace the same and bring substitute DG set within a deadline of 3 days from outage, which shall be treated as idle period and no hire charges payment shall be made for this period. In the case of Contractor's failure to do so, BHEL shall make alternative arrangements at the risk and cost of the contractor.
 - 16.0 Necessary Insurance Coverage for the DG set including Third Party liability and for the workmen (covering Workmen's Compensation Act) engaged by the Contractor are to be taken at his cost and copy of the same should be submitted to BHEL at Site before work commencement. If any accident/injury occurs to any other persons/public due to proven negligence/non-adherence to relevant safety and other precautions on the part of Contractor/it's employees, the contractor shall remain liable to pay necessary compensation and other expense, as decided by appropriate authorities.
 - 17.0 The Contractor shall follow and comply with all Safety Rules of BHEL and their customer, relevant provisions of applicable laws pertaining to the safety of workmen, employees, plant and equipment as may be prescribed from time to time without any demur, protest or contest or reservation. In case of any conflict between statutory requirement and Safety Rules of the Client referred above, the later shall be binding on the Contractor unless the statutory provisions are more stringent.
 - 18.0 Any loss or damage to BHEL or Customer's property due to negligence of the crew employed by the contractor is attributable to the Contractor. BHEL shall not be responsible for any accident/injury to the Contractor's Crew/staff during operation or otherwise. Contractor has to assume full responsibility of the safety of their crew/staff and to comply with the security/safety regulations of BHEL and others at site.
 - 19.0 BHEL shall provide space free of cost to the contractor at Site, where they are to maintain a shed/container for working facility of their personnel and keeping/storing of their required hand tools, spares, slings, consumables etc. as necessary.
 - 20.0 Contractor has to make their own arrangement for Accommodation, Transport and other amenities like Medical etc. for their crew/staff at Site at their own cost.
 - 21.0 All the statutory requirements as called for by the Labour Laws and other statutory authorities are to be met by contractor and proof of compliance should be made available to BHEL.
 - 22.0 Contractor shall have to arrange entry gate passes for their crew/staff at the Construction Plant Site. Necessary support in regard to forwarding of documents shall be given by BHEL.

- 23.0 Electrical Power/Illumination for your DG set Operation as well as for Maintenance works at Site shall be provided by BHEL at free of cost basis.
- 24.0 The Contractor shall comply with the Plant security regulations in force at Site in entry, exit, movement & working inside the plant premises. The Vendor shall also ensure that all persons engaged by him for the work behave properly with BHEL and their Client. In case of any reported misbehavior, Vendor shall immediately withdraw such employee/person from work.
- 25.0 **TERMS OF PAYMENT:** The Contractor shall submit the bill once in a month at the end of each month. **100% payment after necessary deductions** shall be released from the respective **BHEL Site** on submission of the **tax invoice** complete in all respect accompanied by BHEL engineer's certificate with the following documents, subject to its completeness & correctness in all respect.
- a) **Invoice in triplicate based on the Monthly Hire Charge Rates as per Rate schedule to duly certified by BHEL site Engineer (as detail in Clause 4.0).**
 - b) The service tax, as legally leviable & payable by the contractor under the provisions of applicable law/ act, shall be paid by BHEL as per contractor's bill. However, contractor shall have to submit proof of service tax deposited by them immediately after the deposit but not later than the next bill submitted after the due date of deposit. The contractor shall furnish proof of Service Tax registration with Central Excise Division covering the services covered under this contract. Registration should also bear endorsement for the premises from where the billing shall be done by contractor on BHEL for this project. The contractor shall obtain prior approval of BHEL before billing the service tax amount
 - c) Mobilization & Demobilization Charges, as applicable, with BHEL Site Engineer's certification.
- 30.0 **For bringing DG set to site, the road permit , if applicable, shall be provided by BHEL.**
- 31.0 **INSPECTION OF DG SET AND RIGHTS OF BHEL**
- While all Contractors are advised to furnish the correct specification of the DG SET to be provided in the Technical Bid, BHEL reserves the right to inspect the DG SET before opening of price bid and to reject the same in case it is not found in order up to the stated specification. In such case of rejection, Contractor has to immediately source alternate DG SET for inspection.
- 32.0 **ARBITRATION & JURISDICTION:** As per GCC of BHEL – PSNR.
- 33.0 **REJECTION OF TENDER:** The acceptance of tender rests with BHEL which does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender or any tender and reserves the full rights of rejection without assigning any reasons whatsoever.

35.0 FORCE MAJEURE CONDITIONS: As per GCC OF BHEL – PSNR.

36.0 STATUTORY REQUIREMENTS

The Contractor shall ensure that all statutory requirements pertaining to Contract Execution e.g. Inland Labour Laws etc. are complied with at Site.

37.0 TECHNICAL BID & OWNERSHIP OF DG SET

The Contractor is to furnish all details regarding Correct Specification of DG set and Age Proof, Ownership Details and Insurance Coverage taken for the DG set, Experience of providing the DG set earlier to various companies of repute (by furnishing the order copies of those jobs etc) and all other relevant information regarding the DG set in the Technical Bid.

38.0 PRICE VARIATION

The rate quoted by tenderers shall **remain firm** during contract period and extended period, if any.

39.0 N.A

40.0 INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERER

40.1 No deviations to the tender conditions will normally be accepted.

40.2 The tenderer are advised to physically visit the site and fully acquaint themselves with site conditions, **safety norms being followed / to be followed during working**, transportation routes, various distances and the fact that other contractors would be working in this area their structures are to be protected. The material brought and stacked for construction should not make hindrance to other contractors. No claim whatsoever will be entertained by BHEL on any such account and the contractor's rates shall be deemed to have taken this into account.

40.3 The contractor in the event of this work awarded to him, shall establish a site office at site and keep posted an authorised responsible officer who should hold a valid power of attorney for the purpose of the contract. 41.1 LD shall be applicable as per Clause No. 25.5 of the GCC.

42.0 N.A

43.0 OTHERS

43.1 In case of any contradiction between General Conditions of Contract (GCC) and Special Conditions of Contract (SCC), the latter shall prevail.

43.2 The tenderer shall specifically confirm that he has inspected the site of work and acquired full knowledge and information about the site conditions, wage structure, Industrial climate, total work involved and will not raise claim of any nature due to lack of knowledge of site condition. He will also confirm that local taxation laws at the site have been clearly understood by him.
