NAME OF WORK : **Scrap Collection in CSU.**

ITEM	DESCRIPTION / NATURE OF WORK
A	Collection of CRNGO scrap from Blanking Line pit & Notching scrap from Nothing Line on continual basis to keep the machines running and its transportation to scrap yard.
B	Collection of bundle covers, sheet metal scrap, paper, plastic, strips, jute etc. on regular basis to keep the shop area clear for production activities and its loading / unloading and transportation to scrap yard / identified place .
C	Collection of wooden scrap on regular basis to keep the shop area clear the production activities and its loading, unloading and transportation to scrap yard / identified place .

1. Nature & Scope of Work

- 1.1 Work of daily collection CRNGO scrap from Blanking Line pit (3 metres deep) & Notching scrap from Nothing Line, bundle covers, jute, paper, plastic, metal and wood scrap from process in CSU, its weighing and transportation to scrap yard/identified place.
- 1.2 The scrap size will be of 1000mm cut scrap or continuous scrap after blanking operation.
- 1.3 The scrap yard will be inside BHEL CSU premises as identified by BHEL.
- 1.4 Safe transportation of scrap removed from Blanking line pit and manufacturing block to the scrap yard will be sole responsibility of the contractor.
- 1.5 All facilities, vehicles, tools & tackles for safe transportation of scrap shall be arranged by the contractor.
- 1.6 The scrap collected shall be taken to Weighbridge and get measured and certified by BHEL official before disposal to scrap yard.
- 1.7 The requirement is for unskilled nature of work of scrap collection and disposal as per requirement on regular basis from presses to keep the machines running without interruption. It must be ensured that the machine must not be stopped for scrap removal and that the machine should not suffer any stoppages for the reason of non-removal of scrap. In case of any clarification or explanation is required in understanding the work requirement it should be sought from the concerned shop Executive/ Supervisor.

- 1.8 The workers deployed by the contractors may be unskilled labours.
- 1.9 The successful contractor or his representative shall have to maintain day to day contract with CSU officials. Report on every working day at 8:00 AM to undertaking and supervision of the work. He has to deploy sufficient workers in I, II, III shifts, as per work requirement, even on Sundays and Holidays. The contractor shall be responsible for the good conduct of his employees.
- 1.10 Payment terms will be as following:
- i.) Payment will be done on the basis of scrap removed as certified by BHEL Engineer.
 - ii.) Payment will be done according to the rates in Work Order issued to the contractor. The rates will remain firm for the entire contract period.
 - iii.) Payment will be done on monthly basis.
 - iv.) Service tax will be paid extra.
 - v.) Income Tax at the prevailing rate on gross value of work done and applicable surcharge and education cess shall be deducted from the running bills as per relevant rules unless exempted by the Income Tax Authorities.
- 1.11 Following documents are to be submitted along with the tender documents:
- i.) Service Tax registration.
 - ii.) Last 2 year Income tax returns.
 - iii.) ESI registration.
 - iv.) PF registration.
 - v.) PAN No. copy
- 1.12 Basic purpose of works contract is to achieve planned production of the department on continual basis. It must be ensured that the machine must not be stopped for scrap removal and that the machine should not suffer any stoppages for the reason of non-removal of scrap.
- 1.13 In case planned monthly production is not met due to the reason of non-removal of scrap by the works contractor and the performance of the contractor is not found to be satisfactory BHEL reserves the right to cancel the order and the security deposit submitted will be forfeited.
- 1.14 No idle labour charges will be admissible in the event of any stoppage of work resulting in the contractor's workmen being rendered idle due to any reason at any time.
- 1.15 All disputes between the parties to the contract arising out of or in relation to the contract, other than those for which the decision of the Engineer or any other person is by the contract expressed to be final and conclusive, shall after written notice by either party to the contract to the other party, be referred to sole arbitration of the General Manager or his nominee.

2. General Terms and Conditions:

1. Contractor shall abide by all the rules, regulation and discipline at the shop floor during the course of working and shall ensure the safety & security of the instrument and the workers.
2. Contractor will strictly follow the rules and regulations issued by the Central / State Government with respect to labour laws.
3. BHEL will not be responsible any way for any mishap / accident that may happen during the execution of works contracts.
4. The work contract shall be valid up to 31.03.2010.
5. Contractor should fulfill all conditions of BHEL contracts as provided in instructions to contractors and statutory instructions to contractors as enclosed.
6. Contractor shall provide needed personal protection safety equipments to his workers.
7. Statuary compliances shall be essentially followed by the contractor and the contractor if found to have violated the statutory provisions as provided in the enclosed instructions would be liable to be terminated.
8. There will be no sub-contracting of the work contract.
9. List of persons likely to be engaged for this works contract to be submitted.
10. Security Deposit at 10% of the Work Order value shall be collected from the successful tenderer after award of work before start of the work. Security Deposit may be furnished in DD in favor of BHEL.
11. BHEL reserves the option of extending the contract for a period of three months with the consent of the contractor on same terms & conditions and at the same rates as per work order.
12. The estimated quantities as shown in the tender documents are only indicative in nature. The actual quantity may vary.
