3. The prospective bidders who have downloaded the tender documents from our website are requested to send their acknowledgement and willingness to participate in the tender to the undersigned, through fax or email.
4. In case an offer is not being submitted by the prospective bidders against this tender, they may send their "regret" letter to this office, for information.
5. Offers should be strictly in accordance with the Tender Specifications and General Instructions to Tenderer enclosed herewith.
6. **BHEL reserves the right to go for a Reverse Auction instead of Opening the submitted sealed bid, which will be decided after technical evaluation.** As such, the bidders should submit their best prices in the 'Sealed Price Bid'. However, bidders are required to confirm their acceptance of "General terms and conditions" governing RA specifically in their technical bid. The "General terms and conditions" governing RA are given below in the NIT. Bidders are also required to furnish following details in their techno-commercial bid, for this purpose (RA).

Authorization of representative who will participate in the on line Reverse auction Process;

7. The contractor shall give his explicit confirmation without any deviations to the HSE (Health, Safety and Environment) requirements as per enclosed specification No. TBSM-HSE-SPES, Rev-00 Dtd. 28.10.2003. Contractors are also required to furnish details as per Annexure (HSE) to NIT along with their offer. Offers received without compliance & data about HSE requirements are liable to be rejected.
8. **BHEL reserves the right to include/ exclude the scope of optional items (ETC works of ICT) of BOQ for purpose of evaluation/ award of work and same shall be decided before opening of price bid. In case BHEL decides not to execute the optional items (ETC Works) of BOQ, the clauses pertaining to erection, testing and commissioning activities in the "Terms & Conditions of the contract" should not be referred to and may be treated deleted.**
9. **All T&P and testing instruments required for successful completion of work have to be arranged by the contractor at his own cost and nothing extra shall be paid on account of these.**
10. Clarifications, if any, can be obtained from the undersigned but such requests should be submitted well before the due date for submission of tenders. Due date for submission and opening of tenders will not be extended on such grounds.

11. Certain clauses of the “Conditions of contract for ETC works” have been modified in “Annexure to conditions of contract for ETC works” enclosed with the NIT. Wherever there is a deviation the clauses mentioned in the “Annexure to conditions of contract for ETC works” shall supersede the clause specified in “Conditions of Contract for ETC works”.
12. Technical Bid will be opened in the office of undersigned. If required, technical discussions will be held with only those bidders who have taken any deviations. Bidders representative may be present during technical bid opening for technical discussion, if required. The price bids will be opened subsequently, after Technical Bids of all the Tenderers have been evaluated and freezed. Bidders should quote their most competitive rates as there will not be any price negotiation. However if felt necessary by BHEL, price negotiation will be held with lowest bidder (L-1) only. IT WOULD BE PREFERRED THAT YOUR OFFER IS WITHOUT ANY DEVIATION w.r.t. TENDER SPECIFICATIONS AND THE SAME MAY BE CLEARLY MENTIONED ON THE COVERING LETTER ACCOMPANYING THE TECHNICAL BID.

Offers with deviations are likely to be rejected. However if the bidder insists on any technical or commercial deviations, from the specification and/or tender conditions, the price implication if any, of withdrawing the deviations must be submitted along with the price bid in a separate sealed envelope superscribed “Price Implication for withdrawal of deviations”.
13. Offers will be scrutinized based on the qualifying requirements and only those who are technically and financially capable to execute the Job and who fulfil the Pre-Qualifying Requirements [PQR] are eligible to quote against the above NIT. However, final acceptance of the bidder/ offer shall be subject to acceptance of our Customer/ Customer’s consultant.
14. The purchase preference for central P.S.Us shall be given as per the prevailing Government policy.
15. The Bidders are advised to visit Site to have better understanding of job.
16. Work schedule and the deployment of manpower and T&P resources committed by the contractor in their offer, to match the scheduled completion, shall be submitted by contractor and mutually agreed with site In-charge immediately after the award of work. Further, the contractor shall mobilise at site within two weeks of award of work.
17. Details of qualifying work(s) executed by the bidder will be forwarded to the principal employer for verification of the work with respect to completion, commencement & completion date and value of the work executed. Performance feedback of the bidder will also be sought from the principal employer.

18. The bidder representative may be called for discussion with the committee. His originals may be verified by the committee. In addition to above their organisation chart and detail list of manpower, tools & plants and technical capability will be discussed and ascertained by the committee

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF REVERSE AUCTION (RA)

Against this enquiry for the subject item / work with detailed scope as per our tender specification, BHEL – TBG, New Delhi may resort to “REVERSE AUCTION PROCEDURE” i.e. **ONLINE BIDDING on INTERNET.**

1. For the proposed reverse auction, technically and commercially acceptable bidders only shall be eligible to participate.
2. BHEL will engage the services of a service provider who will provide all necessary training and assistance before commencement of on line bidding on Internet.
3. In case BHEL decides to conduct reverse auction, BHEL's service provider shall contact the vendor directly and impart them the training.
4. Business rules like event date, time, start price, bid decrement, extensions, etc. also will be communicated through service provider for compliance.
5. Vendors have to fax the compliance form in the prescribed format (provided by service provider) before start of Reverse auction. Without this the vendor will not be eligible to participate in the event.
6. Reverse auction will be conducted on schedule date & time.
7. At the end of reverse auction event, the lowest bidder value will be known on the network.
8. The Lowest bidder has to fax the duly signed filled-in prescribed format as provided on case-to-case basis to BHEL through service provider within 24 hours of auction without fail.
9. Any variation between the on-line bid value and signed document will be considered as sabotaging the tender process and will invite disqualification of vendor to conduct business with BHEL as per prevailing procedure.
10. In case BHEL decides not to go for Reverse auction procedure for this tender enquiry, the price bids and price impacts, if any already submitted and available with BHEL shall be opened as per BHEL standard practice.
