1. The vendor should be a registered Hystopathology lab.
2. Qualified pathologist must be available with the vendor.
3. Vendor lab / collection point must be situated in trichy within 25kms from BHEL main hospital
4. Vendor shall have 2 to 3 years previous experience in carrying out similar tests.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

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The following are the requisites to be taken care of while furnishing your offer:

1. Your representative should visit BHEL hospital every working day to collect the specimen and deliver the results. No transportation charges will be provided to the representatives.
2. Rates should be firm throughout the contract period. Rates quoted should be inclusive of all taxes and services.
3. The slides and paraffin blocks of biopsies should be given to us if required for references.
4. The selected vendor has to do any additional investigations if required at the mutually agreed rates.
5. Two copies of Bills may be submitted once in a month in the name of Medical Superintendent. Your Invoice should contain the patients' name, investigations done and the rate etc. The payment will be made by means of cheque. Income tax will be deducted in each and every bill as per rules and TDS will be issued at the end of the Financial Year. PAN No to be furnished in the offer and the Original PAN Card has to be produced for verification.
6. BHEL reserves the right to visit and inspect your equipments and the facilities for the test cited.
7. Advanced intimation should be given for closure due to holidays or for other reasons including break down of equipments etc.,
8. Any change or termination of the contract should be made only after giving one month notice in advance.
9. BHEL reserves the right to process/close this enquiry and the decision of BHEL is final and binding.
10. Lowest prices received against BHEL tenders need not to be technically acceptable as L1 price. BHEL reserves the right not to consider the same.
11. BHEL reserves the rights to negotiate or refloat the tender opened if L1 price is not the lowest acceptable price to them inter alia other reasons.
