The amount is to be deposited as Earnest Money which shall be remitted either in cash (as per Income Tax Act) or by a Crossed Demand Draft/Pay Order drawn on any nationalized bank in favor of Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited payable at Bangalore. MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit along with the offer, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (Five years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM II) or valid NSIC certificate or EM II certificate along with attested copy of a CA certificate (Format enclosed at Annexure -1 where deemed validity of EM II certificate of five years has expired) applicable for the relevant financial year (latest audited). Date to be reckoned for determining the deemed validity will be the date of bid opening (Part 1 in case of two part bid). Non submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bid at par with other bidders. No benefits shall be applicable for this enquiry if any deficiency in the above required documents are not submitted before price bid opening. Documents should be notarized or attested by a Gazetted officer.

Industry under the minimum wages Act for unskilled, semiskilled, skilled and Highly skilled categories. The contractor shall disburse the wages in the presence of the company’s representatives and obtain their signature in the payment register on or before 7th of every month, if it falls on Sunday payment shall be made on previous day.	The contractor shall pay wages to his workmen at the rates as applicable to the Engg. Industry under the minimum wages Act applicable for U.P state or central government rate whichever is higher for unskilled (security guard), semiskilled (armed guard) and skilled (supervisor) categories. Worker is also eligible for other allowances such as attendance bonus, travelling allowance, washing allowance etc. and the contractor shall be responsible for payment of the same. The contractor shall disburse the wages in the presence of the company’s representatives and obtain their signature in the payment register on or before 7th of every month, if it falls on Sunday payment shall be made on previous day.
