Sealed tenders are invited under two bid system, Techno-Commercial Bid (Part-I) and Price Bid (Part-II) from the reputed and experienced contractors with sound technical and financial capability for the subject work.

### 1.0 ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- I) Average annual turnover of the contractor during the last 3 years ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2014 should be at least 30% of the estimated value. (i.e. **Rs.6.70 Lakhs**)

Tenderer should enclose EPF, ESI, PAN, TIN No, Service Tax New registration no., Income tax returns for last three years (FY 2011-12, 2012-13 & 2013-14) and Profit & Loss account and Balance Sheet certified by the Auditor for the last 3 years.

- II) The Contractor should have experience of completing similar works during last 7 years ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2015 as given below:
- (a) Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 40% of the estimated value (i.e. **Rs.8.94 Lakhs each**)
- OR
- (b) Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to 50% of the estimated value. (i.e. **Rs.11.17 Lakhs each**)
- OR
- (c) One similar completed work costing not less than the amount equal to 80% of the estimated value. (i.e. **Rs.17.87 Lakhs**)

Job Completion Certificates from the customer shall be enclosed in support of successful and satisfactory completion of the orders.

**Note :** Similar work means Laying of HT Cables.

- III) The works executed in the own name of the tenderer will only be considered for eligibility criteria.
- IV) Latest solvency certificate (within One year) from the Banker shall be produced.
- V) Vendor/FIRM should have a valid "A" grade Electrical license (at least 11 KV) issued by competent licensing board.

### 2.0 SCOPE OF THE WORK

The detailed scope of work is as per Annexure – I, the special conditions of contract and as per Schedule of Quantities.

**3.0 LOCATION OF WORK**

- 3.1 The subject job is to be carried out at premises of BHEL, Heavy Plates & Vessels Plant (HPVP), Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh State.
- 3.2 The intending tenderers are advised to visit the above place, note down the entry procedures, safety requirements, work permit system etc. and satisfy themselves of all conditions prevailing there before submission of their tenders.

**4.0 EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT**

The tender shall be accompanied with a Demand Draft for Rs. 60,000/- (Rupees Sixty Thousand only) towards EMD both drawn in favour of **BHARAT HEAVY ELECTRICALS LIMITED**, payable at Visakhapatnam.

EMD of unsuccessful tenderers shall be returned to them after acceptance of LOI / FOI by the successful bidder.

**5.0 SECURITY DEPOSIT :**

Security Deposit shall be collected from the successful tenderer as per clause 24 of annexure - I

**6.0 INCOME TAX AND WORKS CONTRACT TAX :**

Income tax and Works Contract Tax as per statutory requirement will be deducted on each payment made to the contractor and TDS certificate will be issued to this effect.

**7.0 PRICE SCHEDULE :**

- 7.1 The prices shall be quoted in the price schedule attached to the tender for the complete scope of work.

**The quoted prices shall be inclusive of all applicable taxes & duties as applicable as on date of tender submission except service tax.** However, Service Tax as applicable shall be paid by contractor and same shall be reimbursed on submission of proof of payment.

- 7.2 The quoted prices shall be fixed & firm without any escalation during the entire period of contract and till completion of the work.
- 7.3 Tenderer should quote the **rates in figures as well as in words** and the amount for each item should also be worked out. In case of any mismatch between the quoted rates and amounts, the quoted rates shall be considered as final. It may be noted that corrections, overwriting etc. are not allowed.
- 7.4 All rates shall be quoted in the tender format only.

**8.0 VALIDITY OF OFFER :**

The offer shall be valid for a period of **3 months** from the last date for tender submission.

**9.0 REVERSE AUCTION :**

BHEL reserves the right to opt for Reverse Auction at its discretion instead of opening the price bids submitted in sealed envelope and any information regarding the reverse auction shall be decided after technical evaluation and shall be intimated to the bidders at appropriate time. General terms and conditions governing RA are mentioned in the special conditions at **Annexure-IX**. The bidders are requested to give their acceptance for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

In case BHEL decides to go for RA, only those bidders who give their acceptance will be allowed to participate in RA and these bidders shall have to necessarily submit 'Online Sealed Bid' in the RA. Non-submission of 'Online Sealed Bid' by the bidder will be considered as tampering of the tendering process and will invite action by BHEL as per extent guidelines in vogue.

**10.0 GENERAL :****10.1 Bidders shall confirm their acceptance to all the terms & conditions of the tender enquiry.**

Deviations to the tender conditions are not acceptable and BHEL-HPVP reserves the right to reject such offers which do not meet Technical / Commercial requirements without any / further correspondence.

Bids not accompanied with requisite EMD, late / delayed bids, incomplete / conditional offers, bids not conforming to the terms & conditions specified in the tender documents are liable for rejection.

**10.2 BHEL reserves the right to modify or cancel or short close the tender at any stage at its discretion without assigning any reason thereof.****10.3 The bidders shall study the Tender documents and all other relevant documents in detail for understanding the scope of work involved before submission of their offers. One complete set of all relevant documents pertaining to subject job covered in the scope of this tender is available at Electrical Maintenance Dept. and the same can be referred during working hours from 9.00 AM to 4.00 PM.**

For any clarifications required on this tender document, scope of work etc., the bidders shall depute their authorized representatives to HPVP, Visakhapatnam with prior intimation to get clarifications from concerned authorities.

**10.4 Dy Manager (WE-M&CI) shall be the Engineer-in-charge for herein after referred to as such in the tender.****10.5 Lowest offer need not be the rate acceptable to BHEL-HPVP. **12.0 TENDER SUBMISSION :****12.1 The Bid shall be submitted in two parts.**

**Part-I : Techno-Commercial Bid shall be placed in one cover along with the following documents :**

- (i) Earnest Money Deposit @ Rs. 60,000/- in the form of Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque drawn in favour of Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited, Visakhapatnam.
- (ii) I.T. Clearance certificates / Acknowledgement of submission of the IT Returns for the last 3 years.

- (iii) P.F. Registration Code No.
- (iv) E.S.I Registration Code No.
- (v) Experience Certificates in line with eligibility criteria

12.2 The tender completed in all respects **shall be dropped** in the **Outsourcing tender box** kept at reception counter, ADM building **latest by 13.00 Hrs. on 08.05.2015**.

Bidders may also send their offers by Post to "Outsourcing Tender Box, Admn. Building, BHEL - HPVP, Visakhapatnam – 530012".

Last date for receipt of tenders is **08.05.2015 upto 13.00 hrs**. BHEL-HPVP is not responsible for any postal or other delays in submission of offers.

12.3 Submission of an offer by a tenderer implies that all the tender documents were read by the tenderer and the tenderer is aware of the scope and specifications of the work, site condition, local conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, free / chargeable materials etc., will be issued to him by BHEL - HPVP and other factors having bearing on the execution of the work.


**13.0 OPENING OF TENDERS :**

Techno-commercial Bids will be opened on **08.05.2015 at 14.00 Hrs.** at Customer Cell, Admn. Building, BHEL- HPVP. The bidders may depute their representatives at the time of opening. The price bid of the technically qualified bidders will also be opened in the presence of representatives of the bidders and the date & time of opening of price bids will be intimated later. In case of reverse auction, the date of conducting reverse auction will be intimated in advance at appropriate time.

**If bids are not accompanied by requisite Earnest Money Deposit along with Part – I (Techno Commercial Bid), then Part-II (Price Bid) will not be considered for opening.**

**SCOPE OF WORK****1. SCOPE OF WORK**

**2. Special Instructions:**

- a. Road cutting if any shall be carried out by the vendor without any financial implication. Clearance of any obstacles in the route like concrete/brick boulders /tree logs etc. is in the scope of contractor.
- b. Works shall be carried out as per instructions of engineer-in-charge in coordination with the Civil department.
- c. All safety measures shall be taken as per safety norms while digging/laying.
- d. Removing and replacing back the RCC/MS slabs/ Plates over the formed cable trenches to facilitate laying or removal of 95 to 120 Sq mm HT XLPE cable shall be in the scope of contractor.
- e. Welding m/c, gas cutting set and regulator and all consumables should be brought by the contractor.
- f. Any clarification & modification of the work should be directly discussed with the Electrical In charge.
- g. The contractor should get proper clearance from the security personnel while taking their materials inside and outside the site. They should maintain an invoice register, which is liable for inspection by the Electrical Incharge.
- h. Crane facility required for the unloading/movement of the equipment are under the contractor scope.
- i. For billing, Pro-Rata basis shall be considered for the quantity actually executed.
- j. All tools and tackles required for the job shall be in the scope of vendor.
- k. Vendor is requested to visit the site before submitting the offer.

**SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT**

1. The contractor should arrange to start work generally between 8.00 AM to 4.30 PM in all working days of the Department and to arrange in shifts also as per the instruction of Engineer-in-charge.
2. Since the work involves different agencies, contractor should co-ordinate with other agencies to plan the work and ensure the progress of work as directed by Engineer in charge
3. The rate includes all depths/heights and leads/lifts including work at any level.
4. Contractor should produce labour insurance to cover accidental risk of all categories of workmen under the workmen compensation Act etc.,
5.
  - a) The contractor shall arrange his own tools like screw driver, cutting pliers, AC test lamp, spanners and other tools required to complete the job along with supply of manpower.
  - b) The contractor shall arrange his own tools, material required for digging, cable laying, masonry work and other tools required to complete the job along with supply of manpower.
6. All tools, plants and materials brought inside the campus should be registered at the security gate while bringing inside. No gate pass will be given to take back the above on completion of work if the contractor fails to show the security department's certification that the material had been brought inside.
7. The quantities indicated in the schedule are only provisional and may vary according to exigencies of work and no extra claim can be entertained on this score.
8. The contractor shall attend the breakdowns / shutdowns, repair works on emergency basis as per the instructions of Engineer-in charge. The work also to be organized on Sundays or Holidays as per the requirement, however no extra claim for working on Sundays/Holidays shall be entertained.
9. The contractor should follow the rules and regulations annexed with for employment of labour by contractors in BHEL-HPVP.
10. **Work Contract Tax** on the bill value will be deducted at source at the rates specified by the Government as per the Act from time to time.

**GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS****1. PERFORMANCE & QUALITY:**

The performance and quality of work will be closely observed and in case, the same is not satisfactory, this contract will be terminated without any notice.

**2. TIME SCHEDULE:**

All the works mentioned in the contract should be completed in all respects within a period of 180 days from the date of issue of LOI. The total contract will be operated in a staggered manner as per the availability of site.

**3. RISK PURCHASE:**

In case the contractor fails to execute the work within the scheduled time due to any reasons, BHEL reserves the right to get the same completed through some other party at the risk & cost of the contractor and any additional expenditure incurred due to the same shall be charged to the contractor.

**4. Bidders shall confirm their acceptance to all the terms & conditions of the tender enquiry. Any deviations to the tender terms & conditions are not acceptable.****5. SUB - LETTING:** Subletting of the assigned work will not be permitted. But in special circumstances, this may be allowed. In such case, the party should obtain the written approval from BHEL before Subletting.**6. DISPUTE RESOLUTION:**

(a) Any disputes arising out of this contract shall be referred to a sole Arbitrator to be appointed by the Unit Head of BHEL-HPVP and the sole arbitrator so appointed may be an employee of BHEL-HPVP. The arbitration will be governed by the provisions of The Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. Place of arbitration will be at Visakhapatnam only.

(b) All cases, suits, petitions, actions, etc. arising out of this contract shall be filed, instituted, tried and auctioned only in the courts, tribunals, forums, etc. situated in Visakhapatnam only and nowhere else.

7. The rates quoted by the contractor should be firm for the contract period. There shall be no revision in contract rates during the contract period.
8. BHEL reserves the right to negotiate for price reduction with L1 party and negotiated price will be considered as contract amount for all practical purposes.
9. BHEL reserves the right to terminate the contract at any stage without assigning any reason.
10. Contractor is wholly responsible for injuries / death of the person employed by him arising due to accident during the contractual period. At any point of time BHEL will not be responsible for any loss / damage to the person arising out of accident for performing the contractual obligations.
11. Withdrawal from contract during contract period in BHEL will entitles forfeiture of Security Deposit.
12. Soon after acceptance of tender the contractor shall enter into a contract with BHEL, Visakhapatnam

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13. The contract agreement shall be entered with BHEL, Visakhapatnam, on valid non judicial stamp paper of the value of Rs100/- to be purchased by the contractor at his own cost.
14. The contractor should abide by the company's Security / safety rules and provide such safety requirements as per statutory rules and requirements of the factories act.
15. Quantities mentioned in the scope of work are tentative. The quantity may increase or decrease while executing the work and there shall not be any price variation.

**16. Earnest Money Deposit:**

The EMD amount payable is Rs. 60,000 /-

EMD by the Bidder will be forfeited as per Tender Documents if

- i) After opening the tender, the Bidder revokes his tender within the validity period or increases his earlier quoted rates.
- ii) The Bidder does not commence the work within the period as per LOI / Contract. In case the LOI / contract is silent in this regard then within 15 days after award of contract.
- iii) EMD of unsuccessful Bidder shall be refunded after acceptance of award of work by successful Bidder. EMD of the successful Bidder will be converted to security deposit.
- iv) EMD shall not carry any interest.

**17. Security deposit:**

Security Deposit shall be collected from the successful tenderer. The rate of Security Deposit will be as below:

For works contract value above Rs. 10 Lakhs and up to Rs. 50 Lakhs : Rs. 1 Lakh + 7.5% of the amount exceeding Rs. 10 Lakhs.

Security Deposit may be furnished in any one of the following forms:

- i) Cash (as permissible under the Income Tax Act)
- ii) Demand Draft in favour of BHEL.
- iii) Local cheques of scheduled banks, subject to realization.
- iv) Security deposit at the rate of 10% from the running bills shall be recovered. However in such cases at least 50% of the Security Deposit should be submitted before start of the work and the balance 50% may be recovered from the running bills.
- v) EMD of the successful tenderer will be converted and adjusted against the security deposit.
- vi) The security deposit shall not carry any interest.

**18. PAYMENT TERMS:**

- a. 90% of the Running Account Bill shall be paid monthly once. Balance 10% shall be paid after completion of the contract in all respects.
- b. 10% Security Deposit shall be deducted from each running Account Bill, if 50 % security deposit is submitted before commencement of the contract.
- c. Security Deposit/Bank Guarantee will be released after the completion of contract period and guarantee period of 2 months or on closure of contract and guarantee period of 2 months whichever is later. Withdrawal from contract during contract period in BHEL will entitle forfeiture of security deposit.
- d. Income Tax & Work Contract Tax shall be deducted as per the statutory rules from time to time.

**GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

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- e. Service Tax and any other tax as applicable from time to time shall be reimbursed on submission of documentary evidence of payment.

**19. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:**

In the event of any delay in completion of work or part thereof as per agreed schedule due to reasons not attributable to BHEL-HPVP, BHEL-HPVP will deduct from the contractor as liquidated damages, a sum calculated at 0.5% of the contract value for each full week of delay subject to a maximum of 5% of the contract value. It is understood and agreed that such amounts do represent the losses suffered by BHEL-HPVP because of delay in work by contractor and it shall not be necessary to BHEL to establish the actual amount of losses suffered irrespective of whether the work or part thereof could be put to any use by BHEL or BHEL's client

Note: Under unavoidable circumstances, there may be an early closer of the total contract. In such case, payment will be made up to the last item completed by the contractor.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF CONTRACT

1. The contractor shall obtain license from the statutory authority. The competent authority (Licensing authority) for the works relating to BHEL-HPVP is the Deputy Commissioner of Labour, Visakhapatnam.
2. The contractor shall pay the minimum wages to the contract labour as notified by Labour Commissioner (central) from time to time. The government order indicating the present rate of minimum wages is enclosed. **Any increase in rate of Cost of Living Allowance/Wage hike shall not be reimbursed to the contractor. Contractor shall anticipate such hike, and quote in the tenders.**
3. The contractor shall pay wage for the weekly day of rest.
4. The contractor shall intimate the General Manager (HR) in writing about the payment days during a month and the wages for the workmen shall be paid in the presence of GM (HR) or his representative
5. The contractor shall be responsible to make payment to the workers on working days at the work site on the date notified, in advance. In case of termination of employment due to completion of work, the contractor shall ensure final payment to the concerned workmen within 48 hours of the last working day.
6. No wage period shall exceed one month.
7. The contractor shall maintain the following registers in the prescribed manner under the statue and shall ensure the availability of up-to-date records near the work place.
  - a. Muster Roll
  - b. Muster Roll-Cum-Wage Register
  - c. Register of Fines
  - d. Register of Over Time
  - e. Register of Advance
  - f. Register of Deduction
  - g. To Issue Employment Card to the Workmen
  - h. To Issue Wage Slip
  - i. In case of termination of employment the contractor should issue service Certificate.
8. The contractor shall exhibit a notice at his work place indicating rate of wages, hours of work, wage period, date of payment of wages, name and address of inspector having jurisdiction. This notice is required to be exhibit in English and also in local language understood by majority of the workmen.
9. The contractor workers are covered under the workmen's compensation to be paid to the workmen involved in an accident, with the competent authority within one month from the date of occurrence of the accident.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS OF CONTRACT**

: 2 :

10. The contractor shall take adequate insurance for payment of compensation act and the policy of insurance should be deposited with the company till the contract is completed. The contractor shall at all times indemnify the company against claim for compensation under any law in respect of any worker employed by the contractor in carrying out the contract and against all costs and expenses incurred by the company thereof, without prejudice to the right of the company to deduct such amount from any amount payable to the contractor whether under this contract or any other contract.
11. The contractor shall maintain register of accidents and intimate about the occurrence of any kind of accidents at his work place immediately along with the details and circumstances leading to accident to the Safety Department of the company and General Manager (HR).
12. The contractor shall be responsible to ensure that his employees follow safety regulations as per statutory regulation and also as per instruction of the company. The company will have the right to object to any unsafe practice and the contractor will abide by the direction of the company in this regard. The contractor shall provide all necessary safety appliances to his labourers and shall be solely responsible for the same.
13. The contractor shall not employ sub-contractors without the prior approval of the company.
14. The contractor shall furnish a copy of the acquaintances of payments made to the workers employed by him for information and records of the company.
15. The contractor shall make arrangement for provision of medical facilities to his employees.(ESI)
16. The contractor shall be responsible to follow the various laws applicable to his workers such as contract labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, minimum wages Act, workmen's compensation Act, payment of wages Act, payment of Bonus Act., and the rules made there under from time to time. In addition to the above minimum wages the contractor should pay 12% of the wage towards P.F contribution, Sunday / Rest day payment and ESI contribution at 4.75% or as per present rate.
17. The contractor shall provide identity badges to his workers.
18. The Contractor should make his own arrangements for providing Tea / Breakfast / Meals etc, to the labour engaged by him and BHEL-HPVP shall not issue any subsidized coupons for this purpose.
