- **PO's shall be issued separately project-wise.**
- **PO's for Main supply and Mandatory spares supply shall also be issued separately besides above.**

TERMS AND CONDITIONS (In conjunction with Tender Enquiry Letter terms) :

1. Pre-Qualifying Requirements:
Bidders have to provide the required details as per "TECHNICAL AND FINANCIAL PRE-QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS" (enclosed as NIT Tender Documents). Bids of only those bidders shall be evaluated who meet the Technical as well as Financial Pre-Qualifying requirements.
2. Bidder to note that this is a conditional Open Tender enquiry and the price bid (Part-II) opening/RA participation shall be subject to following condition:
 - i) Approval of bidder by End Customer (NNTPP).
 - ii) Techno-commercial recommendation by BHEL.Customer approval shall be taken up by BHEL with the customer based on the credentials/reference list being submitted by the bidder. Bidders to note that following has to be the part of their credentials:-
Documentary evidence to show that similar or higher capacity component/equipment / system has been supplied by the vendor. The documentary evidence will be in the form of Material Receipt Certificate or Site Inspection Report, etc from the end user for having received the material by the end user.
3. Bidders has to note that TERMS AND CONDITIONS of the tender shall be as per General Conditions of Contracts (GCC, Rev. 06), Special Conditions of Contract (Rev 01) and as per these Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) conditions. Order of precedence shall be as per clause NO. 35.0 of GCC Rev. 06 (GENERAL COMMERCIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS).

Delivery of main supply: Within four (04) months from the date of approval of drawings/documents, subject to documents submission by vendor as per the submission schedule mentioned in Technical Specification (Annexure-V) from the date of PO and every re-submission within seven (07) days after incorporating all BHEL/Customer comments.

In case there are delays in submission or resubmission of drawing/documents by vendor, that much days would be reduced from delivery period.

Delivery of mandatory spares: Mandatory spares are to be delivered along with the last consignment of main supply within the contractual delivery period.

6. CIF is not available for this package.
7. Bidder has to note that Deviations from NIT are generally not acceptable. Deviations, if any, are to be listed out clearly, as per Annexure-II, of GCC Rev 06, in techno-commercial offer. Any deviation mentioned or shown separately or found hidden in offer, will not be taken cognizance of. In case of deviations from NIT, the bidder shall give the cost of withdrawal of such deviation in Sealed Cover as per Annexure-II, Deviation Sheet (Cost of Withdrawal), as per GCC Rev-06.
8. Reverse Auction: BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. All bidders to give their acceptance for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids, in case BHEL decides to go for RA.

In case BHEL decides to go for Reverse Auction, only those bidders who have given their unconditional acceptance to participate in RA will be allowed to participate in the Reverse Auction. Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit 'online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'online sealed bid' by the bidder will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines in vogue.

Terms and Conditions of RA is attached as Annexure-I. Business rules for RA shall be sent to the bidders before conducting Reverse Auction.

9. Online Registration Portal is operational in BHEL. Non-registered Vendors, who wish to apply may apply through Online Registration Portal available at www.bhelpem.com → vendor section → Online Supplier Registration. All credentials and/or documents duly signed and stamped related to registration has to be uploaded on the website and submit the application for registration. One set of hard copy of the filled-up SRF downloaded from Online Registration Portal duly signed and stamped has to be submitted'.
10. Indigenous bidders will be informed to quote on F.O.R site basis and foreign bidders to quote C&F Mumbai Sea port basis (Insurance shall be in BHEL scope as per clause no 17.0 of GCC-REV-06). However, F.O.R site price for foreign bidders will be calculated by loading their C&F Mumbai Sea port price as per GCC Rev-06.
11. The Bidder along with its associate/ collaborators/ sub-contractors/ sub-vendors/ consultants/ service providers shall strictly adhere to BHEL Fraud Prevention Policy displayed on BHEL website <http://www.bhel.com> and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about any fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it comes to their notice.
12. MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit along with the offer, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (five years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM II) or valid NSIC certificate or EM II certificate along with attested copy of a CA certificate (Format enclosed at Annexure-1 where deemed validity of

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EM II certificate of five years has expired) applicable for the relevant financial year (latest audited). Date to be reckoned for determining the deemed validity will be the date of bid opening (Part 1 in case of two part bid). Non submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bid at par with other bidders. No benefit shall be applicable for this enquiry if any deficiency in the above required documents are not submitted before price bid opening. Documents should ne notarized or attested by a Gazetted officer.

13. Foreign and indigenous bidders participating in subject tender will necessarily have to buy class III DSCs (Digital Signature Certificate) issued by the certifying authorities in India. Basic procedure /checklist is uploaded on "www.bhel.com" for participating in future tender enquires through e procurement.
14. In case of joint bidding, Consent letter is also required for acceptance of part order by foreign bidder and balance by Indian vendor. Total overall responsibility including submission of BG of the contract shall be the foreign bidder.

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Terms & Conditions of Reverse Auction

Against this enquiry for the subject item/ system with detailed scope of supply as per enquiry specifications, BHEL may resort to "REVERSE AUCTION PROCEDURE" i.e., ON LINE BIDDING (THROUGH A SERVICE PROVIDER). The philosophy followed for reverse auction shall be English Reverse (No ties).

1. For the proposed reverse auction, technically and commercially acceptable bidders only shall be eligible to participate.
2. Those bidders who have given their acceptance for Reverse Auction (quoted against this tender enquiry) will have to necessarily submit 'online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'online sealed bid' by the bidder for any of the eligible items for which techno-commercially qualified, will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines in vogue.
3. BHEL will engage the services of a service provider who will provide all necessary training and assistance before commencement of on line bidding on internet.
4. In case of reverse auction, BHEL will inform the bidders the details of Service Provider to enable them to contact & get trained.
5. Business rules like event date, time, bid decrement, extension etc. also will be communicated through service provider for compliance.
6. Bidders have to fax the Compliance form (annexure IV) before start of Reverse auction. Without this, the bidder will not be eligible to participate in the event.
7. In line with the NIT terms, BHEL will provide the calculation sheet (e.g., EXCEL sheet) which will help to arrive at "Total Cost to BHEL" like Packing & forwarding charges, Taxes and Duties, Freight charges, Insurance, Service Tax for Services and loading factors (for non-compliance to BHEL standard Commercial terms & conditions) for each of the bidder to enable them to fill-in the price and keep it ready for keying in during the Auction.
8. Reverse auction will be conducted on scheduled date & time.
9. At the end of Reverse Auction event, the lowest bidder value will be known on auction portal.

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10. The lowest bidder has to fax/e-mail the duly signed and filled-in prescribed format for price breakup including that of line items, if required, (Annexure VII) as provided on case-to-case basis to Service provider within two working days of Auction without fail.
11. In case BHEL decides not to go for Reverse Auction procedure for this tender enquiry, the Price bids and price impacts (if asked by BHEL), if any, already submitted and available with BHEL shall be opened as per BHEL's standard practice.
12. Bidders shall be required to read the "Terms and Conditions" section of the auctions site of Service provider, using the Login IDs and passwords given to them by the service provider before reverse auction event. Bidders should acquaint themselves of the 'Business Rules of Reverse Auction', which will be communicated before the Reverse Auction.
13. If the Bidder or any of his representatives are found to be involved in Price manipulation/ cartel formation of any kind, directly or indirectly by communicating with other bidders, action *as per extant BHEL guidelines*, shall be initiated by BHEL and the results of the RA scrapped/ aborted.
14. The Bidder shall not divulge either his Bids or any other exclusive details of BHEL to any other party.
15. In case BHEL decides to go for reverse auction, the H1 bidder(s) (whose quote is highest in online sealed bid) may not be allowed to participate in further RA process.
