BHARAT HEAVY ELECTRICALS LIMITED, ELECTRICAL MACHINES REPAIR PLANT (BHEL, EMRP) having its Factory and Administrative Block at Plot D-1, MIDC, Andheri (E) Mumbai invites offers from interested parties in sealed envelop for Lifting and disposal of non-industrial waste like packing paper, cardboard, polythene, thermocol, winding tape, tree and plant waste etc. as per the following terms and conditions.

Interested parties are advised to visit our premises, fully understand scope of work and kind of garbage generated in day to day work to avoid any doubts at a later stage. Subsequent to opening of offers no claim in this regard shall be admitted.

1. Scope of Work:

Deploying appropriate type of vehicle as indicated below with adequate no. of labours for lifting of waste and disposal of same at B.M.C. (MCGM) designated site.

- (a) Loading Auto
- (b) Mini Truck
- (c) Full Truck

The requirement of specific type of vehicle/transport mode shall be informed by BHEL in advance with maximum 3 days notice period. However, in case of exigencies the contractor shall be required to deploy required vehicle on the day of call by BHEL.

Note: Normally, the quantity of waste generated per month remains equivalent to 1 no. of full truck load. But this may vary according to our need and operations.

2. Security Deposit :

The successful bidder shall be required to deposit an amount equivalent to the unit rate awarded for disposal by full truck towards security money. Security deposit may be furnished in any one of the following forms:

- i) Cash (as permissible under the Income Tax Act).
- ii) Pay Order, Demand Draft in favor of BHEL.
- iii) Local Cheques of Scheduled Banks, Subject to realization.
- iv) The security deposit shall not carry any interest.
- v) Security deposit amount will be refunded after the satisfactory completion of the contract.

3. Duration of Contract: Initially the tenure of the contract will be for a period of 24 Months with a provision to extend the same for another 12 months on same rates, terms and conditions with mutual consent.

4. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

4.1 The company reserves its right to accept/ reject any offer fully or partly without assigning any reason thereof.

4.2 All Question, disputes or difference arising under/ out of or in connection with the agreement shall be subject to the executive jurisdiction of the court of Mumbai, India.

4.3 Arbitration: Any dispute arising out of this enquiry shall be referred to the sole arbitration of General Manager / Additional General Manager I/C BHEL/EMRP/Mumbai-93 or any officer nominated by him, and arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in accordance with the Arbitration & Reconciliation Act 1996. The award of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties. The Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Mumbai only.

- 4.4 The company reserves the right to terminate the contract at any time without assigning any reason thereof by giving 15 days notice of their intention to do so in writing to the contractor who shall not be entitled for any compensation by reason of such termination.
- 4.5 Bids will be opened in front of the tenderer or their authorized representative (carrying sufficient proof to this effect) who wish to be present on the due date.

5. Price Variation Clause: Price quoted and accepted shall remain firm and effective till completion of the contract including its extension if any.

6. Payment

6.1 Payment shall be made against each time operation with due deduction of applicable Income Tax. The Service Tax as may be applicable shall be paid extra as per prevailing rules. For claiming Service Tax the party shall be required to submit a copy of registration with Service Tax.

6.2 The payment shall be made within 30 days after submission of invoice in duplicate along with all relevant documents. The payment shall be made through electronic mode and for availing this facility the successful bidder shall be required to submit their bank details.

7. Penalty

7.1 It shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor to follow BMC (MCGM) rules and regulations for disposal of such kind of waste. Any interaction or penalty imposed on lapse of contractor by BMC(MCGM) or any other statutory authority shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor and BHEL shall be absolved for its consequences.

7.2 The party shall have to clear the waste with 2 to 3 days notice otherwise BHEL shall be free to get disposed the waste through alternate source and suitable action as deem fit shall be initiated against the contractor including forfeiture of Security Money.

8. Price Quote

The price is to be quoted for three different categories of vehicles as indicated below –

The price quoted shall be inclusive of all taxes and duties except service tax which shall be paid extra as may be applicable. For claiming service tax the contractor shall be required to submit copy of his service tax registration.

On top of envelop the NIT No. with due date and sender's name must be mentioned. With this, the sealed envelop can be submitted in tender box duly kept at security cabin of our premises on or before the due date and time for submission.
