a)	Offers are invited in Three part bid (Un-Registered Vendors)/ Two part bid (Registered Vendors) for the Supply of 15000 Bags of "Ordinary Portland Cement-43 Grade as per IS 8112 : 1989"
b)	Material: Ordinary Portland Cement - 43 Grade as per IS 8112:1989 (BHEL Material Code: HY5530079008); Quantity: 15000 Bags (Each Bag of 50 Kgs); Scope of Work: Supply of "Ordinary Portland Cement - 43 Gr" to BHEL, R C Puram, Hyderabad on FOR-BHEL Basis including unloading at BHEL stores.
c)	For the Bidders who are not Registered with BHEL: Bidders shall submit their Offer in Three Part Bid System. (a) Part - I: Vendor Registration & Pre Qualification Criteria: Bidders who meet all the parameters of Pre-Qualification Criteria (as indicated in the PQC document) are requested to Register with BHEL. Vendor registration documents can be downloaded from the URL http://www.bhel.com/vender_registration/vender.php . Bidders shall submit Vendor Registration documents along with all the required enclosures/attachments that are required to register, along with their Offer and shall enclose in a separate cover. Cover should be superscribed with "VENDOR REGISTRATION DOCUMENTS". Offers of the Bidders who are registered only will be considered for Price Bid opening/Reverse Auction. Failure to submit Vendor registration documents (who are not registered) and non registration before Price bid opening/Reverse Auction may lead to rejection of their Offer. (b) Part - II: Tencho - Commercial Bid: Technical bid with Commercial Terms and Conditions shall be furnished in a sealed cover, superscribed with "TECHNO-COMMERCIAL BID", ENQUIRY NO DATE , & DUE DATE. Bidders shall necessarily enclose filled BHEL Standard Terms & Conditions in Techno-Commercial bid. (c) Part - III: Price Bid: Price shall be furnished in a separate sealed cover, superscribed with "PRICE BID", Enquiry No. date and due date. However, Un-Price bid shall be enclosed in the Techno-Commercial Bid. First Part-I will be opened and Offers of the Bidders who meets PQC and are registered with BHEL, will be considered for opening of Part - II i.e. Techno-Commercial Bid. Offers of the Bidders who are registered and are techno-commercially qualified, will be considered for Price Bid opening/Reverse Auction. All the three covers (Vendor Registration documents, Techno - Commercial bid and Price bid) shall be kept in a big envelop, the details like tender no. date and your address etc. shall be superscribed on the envelop.
d)	For the Bidders who are already Registered with BHEL: Bidders shall submit their Offer in Two Part Bid System. (a) Part - I: Tencho - Commercial Bid: Technical bid with Commercial Terms and Conditions shall be furnished in a sealed cover, superscribed with "TECHNO-COMMERCIAL BID", ENQUIRY NO DATE , & DUE DATE. Bidders shall necessarily enclose filled BHEL Standard Terms & Conditions in Techno-Commercial bid. (b) Part - II: Price Bid: Price shall be furnished in a separate sealed cover, super scribed with "PRICE BID", Enquiry No. date and due date. However, Un-Priced bid shall be enclosed in the Techno-Commercial Bid. First Part-I will be opened along with Part-II of the Offers received from un-registered Vendors. Offers of the Bidders who are Techno-Commercially qualified, will be considered for Price Bid opening/Reverse Auction. Both the covers (Techno - Commercial bid and Price bid) shall be kept in a big envelop, the details like tender no. date and your address etc. shall be superscribed on the envelop.
e)	BHEL is not responsible for any Postal/Courier Delays. Bidders shall ensure that their Offer reaches BHEL Tender Box before 11:00 AM of Tender due date. Offers received after Tender due date will not be considered for evaluation. Please submit your offer without seeking time extensions. Bidder has to give valid justification for their plea for extension and BHEL reserves the right to reject the request without any correspondence on the issue.
f)	Sealed covers superscribing Tender Enq. No. and Due Date to be addressed to Sr. DGM / Pur (Co-ordination), BHEL, RC Puram, Hyderabad- 502 032. If Bidder intends to submit the tender personally, same can be submitted to Mr. B. Ravi Kumar, Sr. DGM/Pur (Co-Ordination), Vendor Complex, BHEL, R C Puram, Hyderabad - 502032. Tenders can be dropped in the Tender Box available at Vendor Complex, BHEL, R C Puram, Hyderabad-502032.
g)	Tenders received after 11.00hrs on the Tender due date will be rejected.
h)	Bidder can also submit offer through email at his own risk. However, such email offers shall be sent only to tenderbox@bhelhyd.co.in. Supplier shall have no claim on e-mail offers sent on any other e-mail ID. BHEL is no way responsible for non receipt of offers sent through email due to server break down / Internet failure/ transmission error etc. In case of e-mail offers, vendor name, address including contact details shall be mentioned.
i)	BHEL has a right to cancel the order for delay in supply beyond penalty period without any monetary or legal obligations.
j)	All disputes arising in connection with the contract shall be settled by mutual consultation. If no agreement is reached, the dispute shall be settled in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the rules made there under. The dispute shall be referred for arbitration to any arbitrator to be appointed by the Head of the Unit, BHEL-Hyderabad. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the Parties. The venue of the Arbitration shall be Hyderabad in India. The Award given by the Arbitrator shall be a speaking award and in English language. All questions, disputes, differences arising under, out of or in connection with this contract shall be exclusive jurisdiction of Sangareddy/Hyderabad Courts, Andhra Pradesh.

Please note that REGRET letter shall not be sent to the tenderbox & do not write tender reference on the Cover.
