TECHNICAL OFFER:

PRICE BID:

1. Duly filled in RATE Schedule as per Annexure- III (To be attached in price bid Attachment section) Any other document uploaded in the price bid, apart from Annexure-III as per tender format, shall not be taken into cognizance for evaluation of offer.
2. The Rates Quoted should be FIRM till the Completion of the entire quantity. No revision in rate shall be entertained after opening of the tenders. If the order may be extended with additional quantities by that vendor have to supply the same material at the same price to BHEL site offices located at Tamil Nadu, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Kerala, Karnataka, Odissa and Madhya Pradesh. However the freight charges shall be payable Extra at actuals against submission of document proof.
3. Rates quoted shall be inclusive of all taxes, duties, including octroi and entry tax etc., on **FOR Destination basis**. Supplier should furnish **ED details** separately in their offer / invoice, for BHEL to avail CENVAT benefits. The ED value will be deducted while comparing your offer to arrive L1 status. We will not furnish any 'C" Form.
4. **100%** payment will be released within 30 days against Supply and on acknowledged receipt of materials (OR) SRV issued by the consignee.
5. Tender Conditions for MSE supplier: MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit along with offer, attested copies of either EM II certificate having deemed validity (Two years from the date of issue of acknowledgement in EM-II) or valid NSIC certificate or EM /I certificate along with CA certificate (Format enclosed as per Annexure - I) applicable for the year, certifying quantum of investment in plant and machinery within the permissible limit as per the act for relevant status (Micro or small) where the deemed validity of EM II is over. Terms & conditions for Procurements of Safety Helmets:

SCOPE

This Standard covers the requirements of industrial Safety Helmets.

COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS

It shall comply with IS 2925-1984 with additional conformance to Shock Absorption resistance, Penetration resistance, Flammability resistance, Electrical resistance, Water absorption & Heat resistance test.

- Authenticated photocopies of the latest test certificates (from OEMs, National Accredited Test laboratories eg BIS.) to be submitted along with the Sample for approval and along with supply of industrial Safety Helmets.
- Vendor/bidder to furnish authorization letter from the Principal/OEM against the enquiry quoted.
- Vendor/bidder to submit along with the offer, authenticated copy of latest certificate of Safety Helmets conformity to relevant IS:2925-1984.
- For Safety Helmets specification. The vendor/Bidder shall confirm their acceptance to the BHEL specification by Signing and Stamping on it.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENT

- The helmet shall be made from strong, rigid FRP material (Fiber reinforced Plastics).
- The mass of the helmet may not exceed 400gms.
- The helmet should be provided with 3 ventilation holes on each sides and total aggregate area of ventilation holes shall not exceed 300 sq mm.
- The diameter of any ventilation holes should not exceed 6mm nor the edges of adjacent holes closer than 15mm. However the condition of usage preclude the positions of ventilation holes, the same may not be provided.
- The helmet shall be provided with Harness including Headband, Cradle and Nape Strap, Chin Strap, Ventilation holes and peak.
- The material for Harness shall be sweat resistant and non-irritant.
- The head band shall be not less than 30mm in width and securely fixed to the shell and crown straps. The headband shall be readily adjustable.
- The headband shall be fitted with anti-concussion tapes secured at least at 4 anchoring points and forming the cradle. The width of the straps shall be not less than 19mm.
- The straps shall ensure a clearance of at least 30mm between the top of wearer head and inside top of helmet crown at smallest size adjustment and wearing height of not less than 80mm max. size adjustment of the headband.
- Tightening of the head band shall be possible through high quality, non-slip ratchet & non irritating material.

DELIVERY

- The delivery should be made within the fifteen days of placing of purchase-order.
- Please quote the FIRM price "on FOR destination "basis inclusive of P&F ,Freight and Insurance.
- CONSIGNEE ADDRESS: The helmets are to be delivered to our sites. The Address of them which are spread over Tamil nadu,Andhra Pradesh,Telangana,Kerala, Karnatka,Madhya Pradesh and Odissa,would be intimated later.
- Quantity required are-90(Ninety) Nos for the current year (2015-16). The total requirement are 500(Five hundred) Nos for the period 2015-19.
- The Quantity indicated are tentative.If the requirements exceed 500(Five hundred) nos the vendor shall supply the Safety helmet on the same price as supplied for the first consignment.
