**Sealed Tenders are invited in 2 Bid System i.e. 'Technical cum Commercial Bid' and 'Price Bid' for the above work from competent contractors. Tenders shall be sold by CPR Department up to 11.00 Hrs on 26.06..2015. Filled tender document shall be received in tender box kept in CISF room at ADM Building entrance gate up to 13.00 Hrs. on 26.06.2015. 'Technical cum Commercial Bid' shall be opened on the same day at 14.00 Hrs. Price Bid shall be opened at a later date after acceptance of 'Technical cum Commercial Bid'. Bidders may bid for any one or more items of the price bid.**

### **TERMS & CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT**

Tenders are invited for Hiring 9 Taxies i.e. 5 Nos. \*brand new 'TATA INDICA' Cars (AC), 2 Nos. \*brand new Non-AC '7 Seater Utility Vehicle,(Bolero or Scorpio)' and 02 Nos. \*brand new 'TATA INDIGO'(AC) as mentioned in the price bid. Bidders may bid for any one or more items of the price bid.

01. The bidding is in 2 stages i.e. (1) Technical cum commercial bid and (2) Price bid
02. The price bids of only those bidders will be opened who qualify the first stage.
03. Bidders are requested to comply with requirements like PF Regn., ESI Regn. Labour licence etc. However, if the appropriate authorities raise any such requirement/claim/challan, the bidder will have to fulfill all requirements for which no financial burden shall be passed on to BHEL. The full burden will have to be borne by the bidder.
04. The bidders are required to quote the **rates in Rupees per Kilometer (Rs./KM) in figures & words** in the Price Bid for each type of taxies. There should be no cutting or over-writing in the price bid. Please ensure while filling the price bid.
05. For the purpose of deciding the lowest bidder against item Nos. 1(1a & 1b), & item no 3(3a & 3b) the following formula shall be used to decide L1:  
  
$$\text{Effective rate of item No.1} = \text{Rate of item No. 1(a)} \times 0.90 + \text{Rate of item No. 1(b)} \times 0.10$$
$$\text{Effective rate of item No.3} = \text{Rate of item No. 3(a)} \times 0.70 + \text{Rate of item No. 3(b)} \times 0.30$$
06. Payment will be made on the basis of actual Kilometers completed to different places. The initial meter reading shall be taken on reporting for duty at Transport pool at BHEL Jhansi. The Final meter reading shall be the meter reading at the point of completion of duty or at BHEL Jhansi. Bidder should submit bill on monthly basis supported with log book, service tax deposit Challan and other related documents. The service provider will submit proof of PF, ESI & Service Tax deposit challan along with the bill if any.
07. Payment of all the vehicles in the each group should be dealt combinedly on monthly basis.  
**\*Brand new means- 'a new vehicle purchased after publication of this tender notice in news paper/website'.**

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- 08 Monthly bills will have to be submitted in the prescribed format. The deductions table will have to be filled up by the contractor with each bill. The Pool Supervisor will make appropriate necessary corrections before forwarding the bills for payment. Bills not submitted in the standard format will not be accepted for which the contractor will be held responsible.
09. The bidder will have to raise monthly bills for the service rendered; these bills shall be scrutinized by BHEL before payment. Failure to submit the bills within 3 months of the service rendered can disqualify the bidder from any claims. BHEL shall not be responsible for making any payment for which bill has not been raised/submitted to BHEL Jhansi. The bills should be in the format in which price bid has been made and should include the deduction items also. Bills not showing deductions will be returned and treated as not received. For price variation bill, please refer Clause 15.
10. BHEL assures a minimum combined business of **20000 KMs (Twenty Thousand Kilometers)** per month for all the five taxies of Item No.1 TATA INDICA and **4000 KMs (Four Thousand Kilometers)** per month for all the two '7 Seater Utility Vehicle'(Bolero/Scorpio) of Item No.2. Similarly **4000 KMs (Four Thousand Kilometers)** per month for all 2 nos. 'Indigo' is assured for Item No.3. This condition is however subject to satisfactory fulfillment of all other terms & conditions. The billing period will begin from the 1st/15th day of a calendar month. Bidder should strive to place the taxies on 1st/15th day of month.
- 11.. The **validity of the contract** shall be **Two years** from date of LOI/Contract. The contract may be extended further on mutually agreed terms.
12. For individual item no. 1, 2 & 3 (i.e. \*Brand New 05 Nos. 'TATA INDICA', 02 Nos. \*Brand New "7 Seater Utility Vehicle,(Bolero or Scorpio)" & 02 Nos. \*Brand New 'TATA INDIGO'), the ordering/contract will be finalized on lowest technically qualified bidders only for full quantity of each item. The bidders are therefore, advice to quote only if they can provide the full quantity of each item as mentioned in item no. 1, 2 & 3. The bidders quoting the lowest price for a particular item shall be considered for ordering for that particular item only subject to price reasonability & techno-commercial suitability. **Thus the work may be awarded to more than one source.**
13. Offers shall be accompanied with **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs.1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand only)** in the form of Demand Draft, in favour of BHEL Jhansi or BHEL cash deposit receipt. Bidders can also submit one time EMD by depositing Rs. 2,00,000.00 (Two Lakhs) in cash office & certificate of one time EMD may be enclosed along with tender. **Offers without EMD shall be rejected.** The EMD shall be refunded to the unsuccessful bidder(s) after award of work by BHEL and acceptance by the successful bidder.

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14. **Security Deposit (SD):** Security deposit shall be as per Works Policy 2008 Para-8.2 will be collected from the successful bidder **before start of the work** in the form of either Cash or Pay order or DD or NSS or KVP or Bank Guarantee. The directives given in BHEL Works Policy 2008 shall be fully followed. **EMD of Rs.1,50,000/-** may be treated as Security Deposit for the contractor to whom the contract is awarded. The S.D will be refunded to the contractor after satisfactory completion of the work and after making necessary recoveries, if any compliance certificate regarding PF, ESI etc. shall be provided by CPR before release of SD.

Successful bidder will pay the Stamp Duty on Security Deposit as per government Rules.

15. **Price variation clause:**

(a). The rates agreed between BHEL and the bidders will remain firm during the currency of the contract. However the rates will increase/decrease by 30% of the percentage increase/decrease in the average retail price of Diesel prevailing on the date of tender opening (Techno Commercial Bid-Part-1). Any increase/decrease so allowed to the bidders will be extra/less and form the part of basic rate (Per Kilometer Rate of Taxi). This increase/decrease will be done, only quarterly, as under:-

(b) The rates at which the work is awarded initially will remain firm till the end of that quarter (31<sup>st</sup> March, 30<sup>th</sup> June, 30<sup>th</sup> September & 31<sup>st</sup> December) without any PVC. For example, if rate contract is effective from 1<sup>st</sup> January, rates will remain firm up to 31<sup>st</sup> March but may change from 1<sup>st</sup> April and will remain same up to 30<sup>th</sup> June. If rate contract is effective from 30<sup>th</sup> March, rate will change from 1<sup>st</sup> April which will remain same up to 30<sup>th</sup> June.

(c) The retail sale price (RSP) of Diesel applicable for Jhansi District obtained from the office of IOCL/HPCL/Reputed dealers shall be the basic for calculation of Price Change of taxi per kilometer rate.

(d) Percent increase/decrease in taxi rate shall be 0.30 times of percent increase/decrease in average retail sale price (RSP) of diesel w.r.t. base rate indicated in tender.

(e) Example:

If the RSP of diesel are as following:-

**Assumed retail sale price in Rs 50.00/per ltr. as on Base date on 15th January ,2015**

On 1st February, 2015 - Rs. 52.00/per ltr (Revised Rate).

On 1st March, 2015 - Rs. 53.00/per ltr (Revised Rate).

On 1st April, 2015 - Rs. 55.00 per ltr (Revised Rate).

Average:

$(52.00+53.00+55.00)/3 = \text{Rs. } 53.33 \text{ /per ltr (Revised Rate)}$

Percentage increase/decrease w.r.t. RSP on base date:

$(53.33-50.00)/50.00 \times 100 = 6.66 \%$

Percentage change in Taxi per kilometer rate will be:

$0.30 \times 6.66\% = \% 1.998$

This increase/decrease in Per Kilometer Taxi Rates shall be applicable in the period from 1st April, 2015 to 30th June, 2015.

(f) Taxi per kilometer rate increase/decrease on any other account shall not be permissible.

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## **DEDUCTION**

16. The driver of the vehicles should be well behaved and courteous with the passengers. He should display restraint and wisdom in dealing with excited passengers. In case of misbehavior by the driver, a penalty of upto Rs.50/- can be imposed for each occasion. In case there are multiple repetitions with a particular driver, he will have to be changed.
17. One set of cleaned & ironed white seat covers will have to be kept ready for providing during VIP visits. In case of failure to do so, BHEL will get the same prepared and deduct the amount from the bills apart from recovering a penalty of Rs.500/- per vehicle.
18. The bidder will have to provide two pairs of clothing to each driver which shall include one light blue shirt with piping, one navy blue trousers (pant) & belt and one pair of black shoes. An amount of Rs.500/- for one set of uniform shall be admissible on submission of bills for the same and verification by the Pool Supervisor. The shirt should have a label showing the name of the Firm on the left and a name plate pinned on the right side of the shirt showing the name of the driver. If bidder fails to complete anything, BHEL will complete it at the risk and cost of the bidder.
19. This dress shall become the property of the contractor/driver after 1 years provided the uniform is worn regularly. In case the uniform is not worn, penalty @ Rs.10 per day is liable to be levied. In case this continues for more than 30 days, the amount of Rs.500/- can be recovered back.
20. The driver will have to be provided with a mobile phone. He will keep the mobile phone charged and in fully operative condition. Failure to keep/keep ON the mobile phone would entail a penalty of Rs.50/- per day subject to maximum Rs.500/- per month per vehicle.
21. The contact person mentioned in Part-'A' of this bid will have to meet the Pool Supervisor at least once every fortnight for obtaining feedback about the operation of the taxis. The instructions issued by the Pool Supervisor will be noted down by the contact person in Two Copies, one each for the contractor and BHEL. Non-reporting in any fortnight can result in a penalty of Rs.100/- for each lapse. Similarly the contact person will meet the Transport Executive once every alternate month and discuss the issues for smooth running of the contract. Failure to comply with this provision can result in a penalty of Rs.100/- for each lapse.
22. In case of breakdown of the taxi on any day, another taxi will have to be provided. In case of failure to provide another car, a penalty @ Rs.500/- per day will be imposed. This will be allowed only for maximum 7 days, after which management reserves the right to terminate the contract at the risk & cost of the bidder.

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23. The front & rear wind screens should have a sticker reading "ON BHEL DUTY". The taxi will be parked at our Main Gate for which suitable place will be provided. In case of failure to do so, BHEL shall do the same, deduct the charges from the contractor's bills and recover a penalty of Rs.100/- per car.
24. The vehicle will remain on duty for 24 hours every day. The actual duty hours will be intimated separately. A weekly off can be given on a day convenient to BHEL Management. Failure to report at the specified time can result in a penalty of Rs.10/- for each lapse subject to maximum one hour late, beyond which the penalty shall be Rs.100/-. In case of habitual late coming grater penalty can be imposed.
25. Item No. 1b & 3b will be applicable only on written instructions of Transport Pool Supervisor/Executive. This can be permitted in VIP visits only from 15th March to 15th October between 8 AM & 10 PM only. Payment of these items will not be allowed without supporting instructions of Transport Pool Supervisor/Executive. Deviations from the dates & timings mentioned above, can be permitted only by written approval of HOD/CPR depending on weather conditions. Driver will have to put on the AC on the demand/instructions of user after taking permission/instructions from Transport Pool Supervisor/Executive. Failure to comply would result in deduction of penalty of 10% cost of the rate/trip charges.
26. Placard indicating name of Guest, name of Company etc. will have to be displayed by the driver at the Railway station for receiving incoming guests. The Transport Pool In-charge will give details from time to time. Failure to comply with this provision may result in a penalty of Rs.100/- per incident. Each vehicle has to keep two sketch pens, white sheets, blade & cello tape for writing the name of the arriving guest and paste it on the front wind screen.
27. In case the vehicle goes out of U.P. State on BHEL duty, the service provider has to obtain road permit for the same. Expenditure incurred on this account shall be reimbursed along with the payment of bill on documentary proof. Failure to timely arrangement of permit would result in a penalty of upto Rs.500/- per incident.
28. The Car will have to be maintained by the contractor in good running condition which includes at least the following:
- Minimum noise of engine and body while running;
  - Tyres with proper treads;
  - Inflated Stepney;
  - Working headlights, tail lamps, indicators, speedometer, milometer, temperature indicator etc;
  - Proper paint on the outside;
  - Good condition of bumpers;
  - Upholstery in good condition including washed and ironed white seat covers;
  - Proper locking of all doors;
  - Proper closing and opening of all windows;
  - Dusting of dashboard, rear board, matting, windscreen, windows and body.

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Failure to maintain the same would invite penalty @ 1% of bill for each failure for the duration of the failure/lapse.

29. While on Station duty, taxi will have to be parked near Main Porch/Enquiry/Statues. Railway Station/other places parking charges in Jhansi to be borne by the contractor. No reimbursement shall be allowed for this. Failure would result in penalty of Rs.50/- per incident.
30. Carrier to be provided on roof top for item Nos. 1. Failure to do so would result in a penalty of Rs.500/- per month
31. During out station trips, cash for fuel/driver's personal expenditure, other State permit charges etc. will have to be provided in advance by contractor otherwise a penalty of upto Rs.1000/- per incident can be imposed by apart from actual charges incurred. On repeated failure, greater penal action can be taken.
32. The contractor has to ensure that filling of the fuel in the vehicle is done form the petrol pump situated near BHEL. In case it is found otherwise, penalty of Rs.100/- per occasion can be imposed on the contractor.
33. The bidder will have to maintain a logbook provided by us and the signature(s) of the authorized person to travel will have to be obtained to certify the trips; failure to obtain the name & signature can deprive him of payment for the trip. The logbook will be the Company's property and driver has to keep it in the safe custody. No unauthorized person should be allowed to travel in the taxi when on BHEL official duty. Failure to comply with this provision can result in non-payment of the trip.

## **SPECIAL**

34. Contractor/Operator will have to fulfill all legal obligations regarding minimum wages, PF, ESI, Pollution Norms, Motor Vehicle Act, Service tax etc. as may be applicable to him. The vehicles should have valid taxi permit issued by R.T.O., Jhansi. The vehicle must be comprehensively insured for driver, passengers & the third party for the period of the contract.
35. The vehicle may be deputed for election duties. During this period, payment shall be made as per contract after deducting the cost of fuel and other reimbursement received, if any, by the driver from the Election authorities.
36. The vehicle(s) may be required to go outside Jhansi. Permit charges of other States be reimbursable against documentary proof.
37. Driver should have valid driving licence for commercial light Motor vehicles. Driver without licence will not be permitted.

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38. The contractor has to abide by all laws, rules & regulations of Government, applicable to this type of work. Ignorance of the same does not entitle him to any concessions or claims.
39. Any dispute(s) or difference(s) arising out of or in connection with the contract shall to the extent possible in the first instance be resolved amicably between the contractor and BHEL.

In case a dispute is not resolved, the same shall be referred for conciliation by an officer of BHEL. In case, it still remains unresolved, the dispute will be referred for arbitration by an officer of BHEL. (In case arbitration by an officer of BHEL's is not acceptable, the same could be entrusted to any mutually agreeable common functionary or an independent person). The arbitrator will give his award within the shortest period. The award of the arbitrator shall be final, conclusive and binding on both parties.

The arbitration proceeds shall be conducted in accordance with "Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 or any statutory modification thereof. Language of the Arbitration proceedings shall be in English. The venue of Arbitration shall be Jhansi, India. The court of Jhansi shall have exclusive jurisdiction.

40. Any matter of dispute arising out of or in connection with this contract shall be under jurisdiction of Jhansi Court only.
41. The Contractor has to make an agreement with BHEL in the format prescribed only on Rs. 100/- Non-Judicial Stamp Paper.
42. **In case of non satisfactory performance of the contract and/or any irregularity in meter reading/ log book, Tampering in Milometer etc., BHEL shall have a right of forfeiting the security deposit and cancellation of the contract.**
43. The Contractor shall compensate BHEL for any loss or damage to the plant/property, material of BHEL due to his workmen/ representatives' negligence or otherwise during execution of work contract.
44. The Contractor shall get the character & antecedents of his own labours verified from District Magistrate's office and intimate the same to the management. before deploying them to work.
45. BHEL reserves the right to accept or reject any or on offers without assigning any reason (s). The dispute arising out of or in relation of this agreement shall be referred to arbitrator who may be a serving/retired Sr. Officer or any other person of repute whose award shall be binding on both the parties to the agreement. In case any of the parties decides to obtain relief from the court, the dispute arising out this agreement shall be subject to Jhansi jurisdiction.

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## NOTE:

1. All the three type of vehicals (ie.- 'INDICA', '7 Seater Utility Vehicle,(Bolero or Scorpio)' 'INDIGO') shall be operated by Diesel only. All the vehical should be brand new models without factory fitted gas-system. If during the contract period, it is found that is same is run by other fuel/gas, suitable action shall be taken against the bidder/contractor or contract may be terminated.
2. The documentary evidence for brand new vehicle shall be produced before execution of the contract. **Brand New vehicle means "vehicle purchased after publication of this tender notice in news paper/website.**
3. The deductions shown in the tender documents are the integral part of tender/contract.
4. The contractor shall insure proper and correct running of milometer. In case tampering in milometer is found, the vehicle will be immediately seized and contract will be terminated with forfeiting the security deposit.
