This delivery schedule will be subject to following conditions: -

- a) The input data/drawing will be furnished/ provided by BHEL within 7 days of LOI or during kick-off meeting.
- b) Vendor has to submit P&ID for MRS package, Sub Vendors List, Drgs. Submission Schedule, Bar Chart etc. within 8 weeks of LOI/PO and resubmission of drawings/documents within 2 weeks of BHEL comments, if any. Approval of drawings/ documents by BHEL & NTPC shall be arranged in total cumulative 8 weeks' time. If reasons for delay in approval of drgs./docs. not attributable to the vendor then suitable delivery extension may be given. Other Drawings/documents submission schedule will be discussed in Kick-off Meeting.
- 20) Bidders to quote freight charges in percentage of ex-works (applicable for indigenous bidders only).
- 21) CIF allocation for this package is NIL, bidders to quote accordingly.**
