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BHEL reserves the right to decide the successful bidder on the basis of Reverse Auction process. In such case all qualified bidders will be intimated regarding procedure/ modality for Reverse Auction process prior to Reverse Auction and price will be decided as per the rules for Reverse Auction.

However, if reverse auction process is unsuccessful as defined in the RA rules/procedures, or for whatsoever reason, then the sealed 'PRICE BIDS' will be opened for deciding the successful bidder. BHEL's decision in this regard will be final and binding on bidder.

1. Against this enquiry for the subject item/ system with detailed scope of supply as per enquiry specifications, BHEL may resort to "REVERSE AUCTION PROCEDURE" i.e., ON LINE BIDDING (THROUGH A SERVICE PROVIDER). The philosophy followed for reverse auction shall be English Reverse (No ties).
2. BHEL reserves the right to go for Reverse Auction (RA) instead of opening the sealed envelope price bid, submitted by the bidder. This will be decided after techno-commercial evaluation. All bidders to give their acceptance for participation in RA. Non-acceptance to participate in RA may result in non-consideration of their bids. In case BHEL decides to go for Reverse Auction, only those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in RA will be allowed to participate in the Reverse Auction. Those bidders who have given their acceptance to participate in Reverse Auction will have to necessarily submit „online sealed bid" in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of „online sealed bid" by the bidder will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines in vogue.
3. For the proposed reverse auction, technically and commercially acceptable bidders only shall be eligible to participate.
4. Those bidders who have given their acceptance for Reverse Auction (quoted against this tender enquiry) will have to necessarily submit 'online sealed bid' in the Reverse Auction. Non-submission of 'online sealed bid' by the bidder for any of the eligible items for which techno-commercially qualified, will be considered as tampering of the tender process and will invite action by BHEL as per extant guidelines in vogue.
5. BHEL will engage the services of a service provider who will provide all necessary training and assistance before commencement of on line bidding on internet.
6. In case of reverse auction, BHEL will inform the bidders the details of Service Provider to enable them to contact & get trained.
7. Business rules like event date, time, bid decrement, extension etc. also will be communicated through service provider for compliance.
8. Bidders have to fax the Compliance form (annexure IV) before start of Reverse auction. Without this, the bidder will not be eligible to participate in the event.
9. In line with the NIT terms, BHEL will provide the calculation sheet (e.g., EXCEL sheet) which will help to arrive at "Total Cost to BHEL" like Packing & forwarding charges, Taxes and Duties, Freight charges, Insurance, Service Tax for Services and loading factors (for noncompliance to BHEL standard Commercial terms & conditions) for each of the bidder to enable them to fill-in the price and keep it ready for keying in during the Auction.
10. Reverse auction will be conducted on scheduled date & time.
11. At the end of Reverse Auction event, the lowest bidder value will be known on auction portal.
12. The lowest bidder has to fax/e-mail the duly signed and filled-in prescribed format for price breakup including that of line items, if required, (Annexure VII) as provided on case-to-case basis to Service provider within two working days of Auction without fail.
13. In case BHEL decides not to go for Reverse Auction procedure for this tender enquiry, the Price bids and price impacts, if any, already submitted and available with BHEL shall be opened as per BHEL's standard practice.
14. Bidders shall be required to read the "Terms and Conditions" section of the auctions site of Service provider, using the Login IDs and passwords given to them by the service provider before reverse auction event. Bidders should acquaint themselves of the "Business Rules of Reverse Auction", which will be communicated before the Reverse Auction.
15. If the Bidder or any of his representatives are found to be involved in Price manipulation/ cartel formation of any kind, directly or indirectly by communicating with other bidders, action as per extant BHEL guidelines, shall be initiated by BHEL and the results of the RA scrapped/ aborted.

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**III. TECHNO-COMMERCIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. Product quoted by bidder should meet technical specification mentioned.
2. No Consortium bidding is allowed for this tender.
3. Offers for part quantity shall be rejected, i.e. bidder must quote for total quantity as per Enquiry.
4. Price submitted shall be valid for (a) 3 Months from the date of opening of technical bid **and** (b) till the supply of full quantity of cement against MDCCs issued within the validity of the purchase order.
5. **Price:** Bidders should submit the prices in Indian Rupees only.
6. **Terms of delivery:** Suppliers shall quote on FOR Destination basis only. Destination is 4x270 MW TS GENCO BHADRADRI, Manuguru Telangana Site.
7. The contractual delivery period of 2 weeks (14 Days) will be reckoned from the date of MDCC, which shall be binding on the supplier. Delivery is the essence of all contracts for BHEL. Offers of bidder, whose delivery schedule is not in-line with BHEL, would not be considered further in the tender, and their Price Bid will not be considered.
8. **Opening of offers:** Tenders shall be received up to 1500 Hours on the said due date and be opened on the same day at 1530 Hours. Tenders received after 1500 Hours shall not be opened. The times indicated are Indian Standard Time (IST).
9. If a Supplier submits single –part bid containing combined bids e.g. techno-commercial bid & price bid together, the bid is liable for rejection.
10. **Quantities for Ordering:** Order (for 20,000MT +/-30%) shall be as below:
  - ❖ 20,000 MT (+/- 30%) to be supplied **through Cement Bulker (s)**.
11. **Evaluation criteria:**
  - 11..1 The price bids of the techno-commercially acceptable offers alone, contained in Cover II shall be opened.
  - 11..2 **Tenders** will be evaluated on the basis of delivered cost, i.e. total cost to the BHEL, taking into consideration loadings, if any, and all available financial advantages, including those available from Owner, taxation authorities etc. (i.e. CENVAT credit of Excise duty/CVD/Service Tax & VAT credit).
  - 11..3 In case of interstate supplies, the entry tax liability of BHEL, if any shall be loaded for the evaluation. Bidders have to mention it (if any), in their price bid.

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11.4 BHEL shall issue "C-Form" in case of supply of cement from outside Gujarat state. If delivery is made from within Gujarat state and supplier charges local sales tax by issuing VAT tax invoices, credit shall be given for such local tax, for the purpose of evaluation.

11.5 **GST**: As and when GST becomes applicable to this contract, the net differential (negative or positive) financial liability of the bidder to the Authorities (as compared to such liability prior to applicability of GST), if any, shall be to the account of BHEL. For this purpose, all available options under the GST shall be explored, and the decision of BHEL in this regard shall be final and binding on the bidder.

12. BHEL is intending to engage one/two/three agency (ies) only of ordering. BHEL shall give counter offer based on the L-1 accepted rates to remaining bidders (L-2, L-3 & L-4.....so on) in order of their price competitiveness (L-2, then L-3 & hence forth) for their acceptance for further award of order till total three agencies including L-1 agency is identified.

Modality of ordering for Rate Contract of supply of cement with one or more agencies shall be as below:

**Case 1:** In case none of the other bidders (L-2, L-3 & L-4.....so on) matches L-1 accepted price: 100% quantities may be ordered on L-1 bidder.

**Case 2:** In case one of the other bidders (L-2, L-3 & L-4.....so on) matches L-1 accepted price: Then attempt may be made to distribute the order approximately (wherever possible) in the ratio of 60:40 between L1 bidder and the other bidder.

**Case 3:** In case two of the other bidders (L-2, L-3 & L-4.....so on) matches L-1 accepted price: Then attempt may be made to distribute the order in the ratio of 50:30:20 in the order of their price competitiveness.

13. **Packing:** The cement should be delivered at site through cement bulker (s) of sufficient capacity **only** in line with MDCC (Material Dispatch Clearance Certificate) issued by BHEL, 4x270 MW TS GENCO BHADRADRI, Manuguru Telangana Site

14. **Weighment:** BHEL or BHEL approved third party weighment shall be final and payment will be done accordingly. Variation in weights will be governed by **IS 8112**.

15. **Material Dispatch Clearance Certificate (MDCC):**

Dispatch clearance of required quantity of cement would be given by BHEL 4x270 MW TS GENCO BHADRADRI, Manuguru Telangana Site. Complete delivery of the MDCC quantity should be made at site **within 7-14** days from date of dispatch clearance (**MDCC**).

The validity of the purchase order will be for six months **OR** the complete delivery of cement tonnage (as mentioned in the PO) from the date of issuance of Purchase Order.

Supply for the entire ordered quantity shall have to be made to BHEL site at the ordered rate as mentioned in the PO. The tentative supply of cement to site may commence from February 2016 onwards.

16. **Transit Insurance:** Transit insurance from supplier's works/godown to BHEL site stores shall be arranged by BHEL. Upon dispatch of material supplier has to immediately intimate underwriter of BHEL failing which transit loss if any would be borne by supplier.

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**17. Payment Terms:**

17..1 90% payment shall be released within 30 days after receipt & acceptance of material at site and submission of following documents:-

- a) Invoice in triplicate / Original Excise Invoice (as applicable)
- b) Copy of Intimation to Insurance Company
- c) Copy of Material Dispatch Clearance Certificate issued by BHEL site.
- d) Copy of manufacturer's test result in original showing compressive strength of 3 and 7 days results accepted by BHEL/Site
- e) Guarantee Certificate.
- f) Weighment slip certified by BHEL/site.

17..2 Balance 10% payment shall be released within 30 days on submission of following documents:-

- a) Copy of Invoice in triplicate along with Delivery challan.
- b) Copy of Store Receipt Voucher
- c) Copy of manufacturer's test result in original showing compressive strength of 3, 7 & 28 days results accepted by BHEL/Site.

17..3 Paying Authority shall be CONSTRUCTION MANAGER, 4x270 MW TS GENCO BHADRADRI, Manuguru Telangana Site.

**17..4 For Intrastate supplies Original VAT Invoice is to be submitted to BHEL for getting payment.**

18. For any deviation sought in Payment terms by bidder w.r.t. payment term, following loading shall be followed during evaluation of price bids:

- Base rate of State Bank of India (SBI) (as applicable on the date of bid opening; Techno-commercial bid opening in case of two part bids) + 6%; shall be considered for loading for the period of relaxation sought by bidders.
- ~~On account of payment through LC, if insisted by bidder, all LC related Bank charges shall also be loaded for the deviation in (i) opening of LC by BHEL and (ii) period and amount of LC w.r.t. NIT norms, as per the prevailing bank rates.~~

19. Liquidated Damages/Penalty:

- LD shall be 0.5% per week or part thereof of the total value of undelivered portion of the material for which Material Dispatch Clearance Certificate (MDCC) has been issued by BHEL subject to a maximum of 10% of the total MDCC value.
- In case bidder is not accepting the penalty clause for delayed supply, the offer of bidder shall be loaded to the extent to which it is not agreed by the bidder during price bid evaluation.

20. BHEL reserves the right to decide the successful bidder on the basis of Reverse Auction process. In such case all qualified bidders will be intimated regarding procedure/ modality for Reverse Auction process prior to Reverse Auction and price will be decided as per the rules for Reverse Auction. However, if reverse auction process is unsuccessful as defined in the RA rules/procedures, or for whatsoever reason,

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then the sealed 'PRICE BIDS' will be opened for deciding the successful bidder. BHEL's decision in this regard will be final and binding on bidder.

**21. Inspection & Testing at Suppliers Works:**

BHEL reserves the right to inspect the material during manufacturing and also to get tested the material under dispatch from third party. The test results of third party test shall be final and binding on the vendor.

BHEL will reserve the right to inspect/test the material during/after manufacturing at suppliers' works, and/or at BHEL Site. In case of rejection at any stage, supplier shall be liable to replace at his own cost.

No material shall be dispatched by supplier until and unless Material Dispatch Clearance Certificate (MDCC) issued by BHEL/Site.

22. Each consignment will be accompanied by BHEL MDCC.

23. Quality of cement is associated with shelf life. Shelf life of supplied cement should not exceed the limit as per IS-specification taking into consideration the date of manufacturing, transit time and use of cement at site within **8 weeks** from the date of receipt at site. Bidder shall ensure supply of cement at site accordingly.

24. **Storage and Handling Plan of Cement:** Successful bidder (s) have to submit the storage & handling plan of cement as per IS: 4082 to Construction Manager, 4x270 MW TS GENCO BHADRADRI, Manuguru Telangana Site site immediately after getting first MDCC from site and before delivery of 1<sup>st</sup> consignment of cement to site.

25. The material shall be guaranteed for a period of **three month from the date of receipt at Site** against any manufacturing defects. If any discrepancy noticed during testing, the cement will have to be replaced to Site free of cost. However, test results of third party test i.e. 3/7/28 days shall be final and binding on the vendor. Removal of defective material from our Site shall be arranged by vendor at their own cost failing which BHEL shall arrange disposal at the risk & cost of bidder and subsequent replacement with a fresh acceptable material without jeopardizing project schedule and without any additional cost implication.

**26. Site Test –**

Site test of cement shall be conducted as per BHEL/Customer's field quality plan. BHEL reserves the right to conduct necessary test at vendor's works if required.

27. The representative of the vendor should be available at 4x270 MW TS GENCO BHADRADRI, Manuguru Telangana Site site whenever required as per BHEL site requirement to provide single window expeditious service and quality checks as per IS codes.

28. BHEL reserve the right to cancel the Rate Contract in case of delay in delivery of cement by vendor and failure to comply with quality requirements. BHEL also reserves the right to place the order on the other bidder who has taken part in this tender, subject to his compliance of procedures of BHEL in terms of price.

29. **Short Closure:** BHEL may short close the rate contract at any stage without assigning any reasons.

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**IV. Instructions for filling the Price Bid**

1. **Bidders' rate shall be exclusive of all taxes and duties.**
2. Packaging and Forwarding cost shall be included in Basic Cost.
3. Transit Insurance is in the scope of BHEL.
